 494-124 <u>Lion Brand LB Collection</u> <u>Natural Wool: Barley</u>

1 Ball

- <u>Lion Brand Size 17 [13 mm]</u>
   <u>29-inch [75 cm] Circular Knitting</u>
   Needles
- <u>Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch</u> <u>Markers</u>
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

\*<u>LB Collection Natural Wool</u> (Article #494). 100% Wool; package size: 7.00oz/200.00 gr. (120yds/131m) pull skeins



### **GAUGE:**

6 1/2 stitches = about 4 in. (10 cm) over Rounds 1-8.

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

#### COWL

With circular needle cast on 64 stitches. Place marker for beginning of round. Join by working the first stitch on the left hand needle with the working yarn from the right hand needle and being careful not to twist stitches.

Rounds 1-4: \*Knit 4, purl 4; repeat from \* around. Rounds 5-8: \*Purl 4, knit 4; repeat from \* around.

Rounds 9-24: Repeat Rounds 1-8.

Bind off.

#### **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.
