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Chicory Cowl

SKILL LEVEL: Beginner (Level 1)

SIZE: One Size

Finished Circumference About 56 in. (46 cm)

Finished Height About 4 in. (10 cm)

MATERIALS

- 795-205 Lion Brand Quickie: Icy
2 Balls
- Lion Brand Knitting Needles - Size 50 [25 mm] ('Speed Stix')

**Quickie (Article #795). 74% Acrylic, 22% Wool, 4% Other; package size: 3.00oz/85.00 gr. (22yds/20m) pull skeins*



GAUGE:

5 stitches + 4 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

1. Cowl is worked back and forth in rows, then ends are sewn together to make Cowl.
2. Cowl is reversible and can be worn with either side facing out.

COWL

Cast on 5 stitches.

Row 1: Knit 1, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit 1.

Rows 2 and 3: Purl 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1.

Row 4: Repeat Row 1.

Repeat Rows 1-4 until about 36 in. (91.5 cm) of yarn remains.

Bind off.

FINISHING

Hold the ends of the piece together and with your fingers weave yarn tail in and out through the ends to

join them. Weave remaining yarn tails through stitches to hide them.
