MATERIALS

- 865-207 Lion Brand Vanna's Palettes: Spirited

1 Ball (A)

**Vanna's Palettes (Article #865). 100% Acrylic; package size: 0.35oz/10.00 gr. (17yds/16m) pull skeins*

- 865-205 Lion Brand Vanna's Palettes: Essential

1 Ball (B)

- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size J-10 (6 mm)

- Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers

- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)



GAUGE:

16 sts + 15 rnds = 4 in. (10 cm) in pattern.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

1. Wristers cuff is worked back and forth in rows, then joined to make a ring.
2. Sts are worked along one edge of cuff, then Wristers are worked in the rnd.
3. To change color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops to complete st. Fasten off old color.
4. Each package of VANNA'S PALETTES contains 8 miniature balls of yarn. In order to follow the Stripe Sequence, so that your Wristers look exactly like those shown in the photo, you'll need to identify each color yarn in each VANNA'S PALETTES package. To identify the yarn color names, check the photograph of the yarn packages at LionBrand.com.
5. The Wristers do not use every color of yarn in the packages. Use the remaining yarn for other projects, or feel free to substitute colors in the Wristers.

Colors of VANNA'S PALETTES

Essential

Toffee (C)

Honey (D)

Mustard (E)

Dusty Purple (F)

Dusty Rose (G)

Beige (H)

Spirited

Toffee (C)

Pea Green (I)

Fern (J)

Silver Grey (K)

WRISTERS (make 2)

Cuff

With C, ch 4.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across – 3 sts.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, working through back loops only, sc in each st across.

Rep Row 2 until piece measures about 7 in. (18 cm) from beg.

Joining Row: Fold cuff in half, matching sts of first and last rows. Ch 1, working through both thicknesses, sl st in each st across to join ends.

Change to D in last st.

Note: Work Rnd 1 into sides of rows around one open side of joined cuff.

Rnd 1: With D, ch 1, sc in each st around; join with sl st in first sc. Place marker for beg of rnd, move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: With D, ch 2 (counts as ch 1, ch-sp here and throughout), sk first st, sc in next st, *ch 1, sk next st, sc in next st; rep from * around; join with sl st in beg ch-sp.

Rnd 3: With E, ch 1, *sc in next ch-sp, ch 1, sk next st; rep from * around; join with sl st in beg ch-sp.

Rnd 4: With E, ch 1, sc in each sc and ch-sp around; join with sl st in first sc – 28 sts.

Rnds 5 and 6: With I, rep Rnds 1 and 2.

Rnds 7 and 8: With J, rep Rnds 3 and 4.

Rnds 9 and 10: With K, rep Rnds 1 and 2.

Rnds 11 and 12: With I, rep Rnds 3 and 4.

Rnds 13 and 14: With F, rep Rnds 1 and 2.

Rnds 15 and 16: With G, rep Rnds 3 and 4.

Thumbhole

Rnd 17: With I, sc in next 28 sts, ch 4 (for thumbhole); join with sl st in first sc – 32 sts.

Note: In Rnd 18, work into each ch of ch-4, just as if the chs were sts.

Rnd 18: With I, ch 2 (counts as ch 1, 1 ch-sp here and throughout), sk first st, sc in next st, *ch 1, sk next st, sc in next st; rep from * around; join with sl st in beg ch-sp.

Rnds 19 and 20: With H, rep Rnds 3 and 4.

Rnd 21: With H, ch 1, working through back loops only, sc in each st around; join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
