PONCHO
RECTANGLE 1
With A, ch 147.
Row 1: With A, de hdc in 3rd ch from hook (beg ch counts as first hdc), * hdc in next 7 ch, sk next ch, hdc in next $7 \mathrm{ch}, 3 \mathrm{hdc}$ in next ch; rep from * to last 16 ch , hdc in next 7 ch , sk next ch, hdc in next $7 \mathrm{ch}, 2 \mathrm{hdc}$ in last ch - 9 ripples.
Row 2: With A, ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, dc in first st, *dc in next 7 sts, sk 2 sts, dc in next 7 sts, 3 dc in next st; rep from * to last 17 sts, dc in next 7 sts, sk 2 sts, hde dc in next 7 sts, 2 dc in last st.
Row 3: With B, turn, (ch 3, dc, Cluster) in same st, *Cluster in next 7 sts, sk 2 sts, Cluster in next 7 sts, 3 Clusters in next st; rep from * to last 17 sts, Cluster in next 7 sts, sk 2 sts, Cluster in next 7 sts, 2 Clusters in last st.
Row 4: With A, ch 2 (counts as first hdc), turn, hdc in first st, *hdc in next 7 sts, sk 2 sts, hdc in next 7 sts, 3 hdc in next st; rep from * to last 17 sts, hdc in next 7 sts, sk 2 sts, hdc in next 7 sts, 2 hdc in last st.
Rows 5-30: Continuing in Stripe Sequence for Rectangle 1, rep Rows 1-3. 2-4 eight times, then rep Rows 2 and 3.

*Vanna's Glamour® (Article \#861). 96\% Acrylic, 4\% Metallic Polyester; package size:
$1.75 \mathrm{oz} / 49.61 \mathrm{gr}$. (202yds/185m) pull skeins

Vanna's Tapestry (Article \#864). 100\% acrylic; package size: $3.00 \mathrm{oz} / 85.00 \mathrm{gr}$. ( $145 \mathrm{yds} / 133 \mathrm{~m}$ ) pull skeins

## GAUGE:

1 ripple $=$ about $5 \mathrm{in} .(12.5 \mathrm{~cm})$ from peak to peak.
When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

## STITCH EXPLANATI ON:

CI (cluster) Yarn over, insert hook in indicated st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook, *yarn over, insert hook in same st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook, yarn over and draw through all loops on hook.
tr2tog (tr 2 sts together) (Yarn over) twice, insert hook in next st and draw up a loop, (yarn over and draw through 2 loops) twice. (Yarn over) twice, insert hook in next st and draw up a loop, (yarn over, draw through 2 loops) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook - 1 st decreased.

## NOTES:

1. Poncho is worked in 2 rectangles sewn together.
2. Rectangles are worked back and forth in rows in stripe sequences.
3. Poncho is worked in a ripple crochet pattern. The ripple pattern is easy to do, but it's important to remember that you may need to work several rows before the ripple pattern becomes clear. The ripple pattern consists of alternating peaks and valleys. Take care to keep the peaks and valleys of each row aligned.
4. When working in ripple crochet, your piece probably won't lay flat until you've worked a few rows (how many rows depends on your yarn and gauge).
5. To change color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops to complete st.

## STRIPE SEQUENCES

Rectangle 1: *2 rows A, 1 row B, 2 rows A, 1 row C**, 2 rows A, 1 row D, 2 rows A, 1 row C; rep from * once, then rep from * to ** once more - 30 rows total.
Rectangle 2: *2 rows A, 1 row D, 2 rows A, 1 row C**, 2 rows A, 1 row B, 2 rows A, 1 row C; rep from * once, then rep from * to ** once more - 30 rows total.

## PONCHO

RECTANGLE 1
With A, ch 147.
Row 1: With A, hdc in 3rd ch from hook (beg ch counts as first hdc), *hdc in next 7 ch, sk next ch, hdc in next $7 \mathrm{ch}, 3$ hdc in next ch; rep from * to last 16 ch , hdc in next 7 ch , sk next ch, hdc in next $7 \mathrm{ch}, 2$ hdc in last ch - 9 ripples.
Row 2: With A, ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, dc in first st, * dc in next 7 sts, sk 2 sts, dc in next 7 sts, 3 dc in next st; rep from * to last 17 sts, dc in next 7 sts, sk 2 sts, dc in next 7 sts, 2 dc in last st.
Row 3: With B, turn, (ch 3, dc, Cluster) in same st, *Cluster in next 7 sts, sk 2 sts, Cluster in next 7 sts, 3 Clusters in next st; rep from * to last 17 sts, Cluster in next 7 sts, sk 2 sts, Cluster in next 7 sts, 2 Clusters in last st.
Row 4: With A, ch 2 (counts as first hdc), turn, hdc in first st, * hdc in next 7 sts, sk 2 sts, hdc in next 7
sts, 3 hdc in next st; rep from * to last 17 sts, hdc in next 7 sts, sk 2 sts, hdc in next 7 sts, 2 hdc in last st.
Rows 5-30: Continuing in Stripe Sequence for Rectangle 1, rep Rows 2-4 eight times, then rep Rows 2 and 3.
Row 31: With A, ch 1, turn, sk first st, sl st in next st, *sc in next 2 sts, hdc in next st, dc in next st, tr2tog, sk next 2 sts, tr2tog, dc in next st, hdc in next st, sc in next 2 sts, sl st in next st, sk next st, sl st in next st; rep from * to last 16 sts, sc in next 2 sts, hdc in next st, dc in next st, tr2tog, sk next 2 sts, tr2tog, dc in next st, hdc in next st, sc in next 2 sts, sk next st, sl st in last st.
Fasten off.

## RECTANGLE 2

Work same as Rectangle 1, following Stripe Sequence for Rectangle 2.

## FINISHING

Working across the top of Row 31, place markers 10 in . 25.5 cm ) from each side edge for shoulders and mark center $10 \mathrm{in} .(25.5 \mathrm{~cm})$ for neck opening. Sew Rectangles tog between neck and shoulder markers (about $8 \mathrm{in} .(20.5 \mathrm{~cm})$ ) and matching pattern.

## EDGING

From RS, join A with sl st at beg of side edge.
Ch 1 , sc evenly spaced along side edge.
Fasten off.
Rep for other 3 side edges.
Weave in ends.
