## GAUGE:

1 Square $=$ about $23 / 4 \times 23 / 4 \mathrm{in} .(7 \times 7 \mathrm{~cm})$.
When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

## STITCH EXPLANATI ON:

twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook - 1 st decreased.

## NOTES:

1. 75 Squares and 10 Triangles are worked separately, then sewn tog into strips, following a diagram.
2. A ripple pattern is worked across one long edge of each of the assembled strips.
3. The strips are then sewn tog to make the Throw.
4. Borders are worked around outside edges of completed Throw.
5. To change color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st. Fasten off old color.

## SQUARES (make 75 - 8 with I, 6 with $E, 5$ each with A, B, F, H, J, M, N, O and P, and 4 each with G, K, L, and Q)

Note: Squares are worked in joined rnds with RS always facing.
With smaller hook, ch 5 ; join with sl st in first ch to make a ring.
Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 3 (counts as first dc in this rnd and in all following rnds), 2 dc in ring, (ch 2, 3 dc in ring) 3 times, ch 2 ; join with sl st in top of beg ch - you will have 12 dc (four 3 -dc groups) and $4 \mathrm{ch}-2 \mathrm{sps}$ at the end of this rnd.
Rnd 2: Ch 3 , dc in next 2 sts, ( 2 dc ch $2,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in next ch-2 sp (corner made), $*$ dc in next 3 sts , ( 2 dc , ch $2,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in next ch-2 sp; rep from * around; join with sl st in top of beg ch - you will have $28 \mathrm{dc}(7 \mathrm{dc}$ across each side) and 4 corner ch- 2 sps at the end of this rnd.
Fasten off.

## TRIANGLES (make 10-2 each with G, I, K, L, and Q)

Note: Triangles are worked back and forth in rows.
With smaller hook, ch 4 ; join with sl st in first ch to make a ring.
Row 1: Ch 4 (counts as first dc, ch 1 in this rnd and in all following rnds), 3 dc in ring, ch 2,3 dc in ring, ch 1 , dc in ring; do not join into a circle - you will have $8 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{ch}-1 \mathrm{sps}$, and $1 \mathrm{ch}-2 \mathrm{sp}$ at the end of this row.
Row 2: Ch 4, turn, 2 dc in first ch-1 sp, dc in next 3 sts, ( $2 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 2,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in next ch-2 sp, dc in next 3 sts, ( 2 dc , ch $1, \mathrm{dc}$ ) in turning ch-sp - you will have $16 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{ch}-1 \mathrm{sps}$, and 1 corner ch-2 sp at the end of this row.
Fasten off.

## FI NI SHI NG

Following Assembly Diagram, sew Squares and Triangles tog to make strips.

## Top Ripple Edging

Note: Top edging is worked across the top long edge of each strip.
The top long edge is the edge that beg and ends with a Triangle (see Assembly Diagram).
Row 1 (RS): From RS with larger hook, join A with sl st in ch-1 sp at tip of Triangle at beg of long edge of one strip, ch 1,2 sc in same ch-1 sp as joining, sc in next 5 sts, sc2tog; * working in edge of next Square, sc2tog, sc in next 5 sts, 3 sc in next ch- 2 sp , sc in next 5 sts, sc2tog; rep from $*$ across to Triangle at end of edge; working in edge of Triangle, sc2tog, sc in next 5 sts, 2 sc in last ch-1 sp.
Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, dc in first st, dc in next 6 sts, sk next 2 sts, dc in next 6 sts, *3 dc in next st, dc in next 6 sts, sk next 2 sts, dc in next 6 sts; rep from $*$ to last st, 2 dc in last st.
Change to $B$.
Rows 3 and 4: With $B$, ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, sc in next 6 sts, sk next 2 sts, sc in next 6 sts, * 3 sc in next st, sc in next 6 sts, sk next 2 sts, sc in next 6 sts; rep from $*$ to last st, 2 sc in last st.
Change to A.
Row 5: With A, rep Row 3.
Row 6: With A, rep Row 2.
Fasten off.
Rep Rows 1-6 of edging across top long edge of each strip.

Following Assembly Diagram, sew strips tog to make Throw.
Bottom Ripple Edging
Row 1 (RS): From RS with larger hook, join A with sl st in corner ch-2 sp at beg of lower edge, ch 1, sc2tog, sc in next 5 sts, 3 sc in next corner ch-2 sp, sc in next 5 sts, sc2tog; *working in edge of next Square, sc2tog, sc in next 5 sts, 3 sc in next corner ch-2 sp, sc in next 5 sts, sc2tog; rep from * across, sl st in last corner ch-2 sp.
Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, sk the sl st and the next st, dc in next 6 sts, 3 dc in next st, dc in next 6 sts *sk next 2 sts, dc in next 6 sts, 3 dc in next st, dc in next 6 sts; rep from * to last sc2tog, sk last sc2tog, dc in beg ch.

Change to B .
Rows 3 and 4: With B, ch 1, turn, sk first 2 sts, sc in next 6 sts, 3 sc in next st, sc in next 6 sts, *sk next 2 sts, sc in next 6 sts, 3 sc in next st, sc in next 6 sts; rep from * to last 2 sts, sk next st, sc in top of beg ch.
Change to A .
Row 5: With A, rep Row 3.
Row 6: With A, ch 3, turn, sk the first 2 sts, dc in next 6 sts, 3 dc in next st, dc in next 6 sts *sk next 2 sts, dc in next 6 sts, 3 dc in next st, dc in next 6 sts; rep from * to last sc, sk last sc, dc in beg ch. Fasten off.

## Side Edging

Row 1 (RS): From RS, join A with an sc at beg of one long straight edge of Throw; sc evenly spaced to next corner.
Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.
Fasten off.
Rep edging across opposite edge of Throw.

## Border

Rnd 1 (RS): From RS, join B with sl st at beg of top edge, ch 2, hdc in first st, hdc in next 6 sts, sk next 2 sts, hdc in next 6 sts, $* 3$ hdc in next st, hdc in next 6 sts, sk next 2 sts, hdc in next 6 sts; rep from $*$ to last st, 2 hdc in last st; hdc in each st across side edge; working across lower edge, sk first 2 sts, hdc in next 6 sts, 3 hdc in next st, hdc in next 6 sts, *sk next 2 sts, hdc in next 6 sts, 3 hdc in next st, hdc in next 6 sts; rep from * to last 2 sts, sk next st, hdc in last st; hdc in each st across rem side edge; join with sl st in first hdc.
Fasten off.
Weave in ends.
