SKILL LEVEL: Beginner (Level 1)

SIZE: One Size

About 12 x 25 in. (30.5 x 63.5 cm), at widest and longest points

MATERIALS

- 861-114 Lion Brand Vanna's Glamour Yarn: **Vanna's Glamour® (Article #861). 96% Acrylic, 4% Metallic Polyester; package size: 1.75oz/49.61 gr. (202yds/185m) pull skeins*
Red Stone
1 Ball
- Lion Brand Knitting Needles- Size 5 [3.75 mm]
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)



GAUGE:

24 stitches = 4 in. (10 cm) in Garter stitch (knit every row).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

STITCH EXPLANATION:

knit in front and back Knit next stitch without removing it from left needle, then knit through back of same stitch – 1 stitch increased.

NOTES:

Kerchief is worked in Garter stitch (knit every row) beginning at point and increasing to create a triangle.

KERCHIEF

Cast on 3 stitches.

Row 1: Knit in front and back, knit 2 – you will have 4 stitches at the end of this row.

Row 2: Knit in front and back, k to end of row – 5 stitches at the end of this row.

Repeat Row 2 until you have a total of 153 stitches.

Bind off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
