

SKILL LEVEL: Easy (Level 2)

SIZE: One Size

About 12 x 25 in. (30.5 x 63.5 cm) at widest and longest points

• 861-109 Lion Brand Vanna's Glamour Yarn: Sapphire 1 Ball

*Vanna's Glamour® (Article #861). 96% Acrylic, 4% Metallic Polyester; package size: 1.75oz/49.61 gr. (202yds/185m) pull skeins

- Lion Brand Knitting Needles- Size 5 [3.75 mm]
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)



GAUGE:

24 sts = 4 in. (10 cm) in Garter st (k every row).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

STITCH EXPLANATION:

Yo (yarn over)

An increase that also creates a small decorative hole (eyelet) in the fabric, worked as follows:

1. Bring yarn to front, between the needles.

2. Take yarn to back, over the right needle. This creates the new st. You are now ready to proceed with the next st as instructed.

NOTES:

Scarf is worked in Garter st (k every row) beginning at point and increasing to create a triangle.

Cast on 3 sts. **Row 1:** K1, yo, k1, yo, k1 – you will have 5 sts at the end of this row. **Row 2:** K1, yo, k to end of row – 6 sts at end of this row. Repeat Row 2 until you have a total of 153 sts. Bind off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
