**SIZE:** Small, Medium, Large, 1X

Chest measurement 14 (18, 22, 26) inches

Finished sweater measurement 15 (19, 23, 27 inches

\*Fun Fur (Article #320). 100% Polyester; package size: **Solids:** 1.75 oz/50g; 64 yd/58m balls **Prints:** 1.5 oz/40g; 57 yd/52m balls **Exotics:** 1.75 oz/50g; 55 yd/50m balls (**Note:** 

Exotics shades are lay flat to dry)



#### **MATERIALS**

- 320-207 <u>Lion Brand Fun Fur Yarn: Citrus</u>
   2 (2, 3, 3) Balls (MC)
- 620-107 <u>Lion Brand Wool-Ease Yarn: Blue Heather</u>
   1 (1, 2, 2) Ball (CC)
- <u>Lion Brand Knitting Needles -</u> <u>Size 10 [6 mm]</u>
- <u>Lion Brand Knitting Needles-Size 9 [5.5 mm]</u>
- <u>Lion Brand Double-Pointed</u> <u>Needles - Size 9</u>
- <u>Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch</u> <u>Markers</u>
- <u>Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt</u>
   <u>Needles (Set of 6)</u>

\*Wool-Ease® (Article #620).

- Solid, Heather, Twist: 80% acrylic, 20% wool
- Sprinkles, Wheat, Mushroom, Rainbow Mist: 86% acrylic, 10% wool, 4% rayon
- Glitter/Multi-colors: 78% acrylic, 19% wool, 3% polyester
- Frosts: 70% acrylic, 20% wool, 10% polyamide
- Prints: 80% acrylic, 20% wool

; package size: **Solid, Heather, Twist:** 3 oz/85g; 197 yd/180m balls

Sprinkles, Wheat, Mushroom, Rainbow Mist: 3

oz/85g; 197 yd/180m balls

Glitter/Multi-colors: 2.5 oz./70g; 162 yd/146m

balls

**Frosts:** 2.5 oz./70g; 162 yd/146m balls **Prints:** 2.5 oz/70g; 162 yd/146m balls



### **GAUGE:**

14 sts + 18 rows = 4 inches (10 cm) in St st (k on RS, p on WS) with one strand each MC and CC held tog on larger needles.

18 sts + 24 rows = 4 inches (10 cm) in St st with one strand CC on smaller needles When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch


#### **BACK**

Beg at neck opening with one strand each MC and CC held tog and larger needles, cast on 40 (54, 68, 72) sts. Work in St st until piece measures 8 (12, 16, 17)" from beg ending with a WS row.

Dec 1 st each edge every other row 8 (8, 12, 12) times – 24 (38, 44, 48) sts. Work even until piece measures 12 (16, 21, 23)" from beq. Bind off all sts loosely.

#### **UNDERPANEL**

Beg at neck opening with one strand CC and smaller needles, cast on 7 sts. Work in K1, P1 Rib, inc 1 st each end every 3rd row 7 (9, 13, 16) times – 21 (25, 33, 39) sts. Work even until piece measures 8 (12, 16, 17)" from beg. Bind off all sts loosely.



#### **FINISHING**

Sew Underpanel to Back leaving a 2 ( $2\frac{1}{2}$ , 3,  $3\frac{1}{2}$ ) inches space on each side for front leg openings at the widest point of Underpanel.

#### Neck

With double-pointed needles and one strand CC, pick up and knit 44 (58, 72, 76) sts

evenly around neck opening. Place marker, join, and work in K1, P1 Rib for 3" or desired length. Bind off all sts loosely.



With double-pointed needles and one strand CC, pick up and knit 20 (22, 24, 26) sts evenly around opening. Place marker, join, and work 5 rnds in K1, P1 Rib. Bind off all sts loosely.

### **Body Ribbing**

With double-pointed needles and one strand CC, pick up and knit 78 (96, 120, 130) sts evenly around Back opening. Join and work 5 rnds K1, P1 Rib. Bind off all sts loosely. Weave in ends.
