Crochet Bright Placemats

Skill Level: Beginner

SIZE

Placemat: 16" x 12½" without fringe [approximately 40.5 cm x 32 cm]

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND Lion Cotton
- 1 ball #148 Turquoise
- 1 ball #147 Purple
- 1 ball #146 Fuchsia
- 1 ball #157 Sunflower

OR COLORS OF YOUR CHOICE

- LION BRAND size H-8 (5 mm) crochet hook OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE
- LION BRAND size K-10.5 (6.5 mm) crochet hook for fringe.

GAUGE

With smaller hook, 14 stitches + 16 rows = 4" (10 cm) in sc. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

NOTE: Pattern makes four placemats, one in each colorway.

PLACE MATS

Make one in each colorway shown above.

PLACE MATS

Make one in each colorway shown above.

With smaller hook and A, ch 45.

Row 1 Sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each ch across, turn – 44 sc.


Row 2 Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn – 44 sc.

Rep Row 2, working in the following color sequence: 3 more rows A; 1 row B; 2 rows A; 1 row B; 2 rows A; 1 row C; 2 rows D; 1 row C; 2 rows A; 1 row B; 2 rows A; 1 row B; 2 rows A; 1 row B; 5 rows A. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

FINISHING

The edge is finished with a fringe of approximately 2 inches [5 cm] in length; one strand of each of the four colors. Fringe assembly is per diagram below; one knot of fringe on every other stitch. Trim fringe if desired.

- 1. Starting at the bottom of the placemat, insert the larger crochet hook through the first outside stitch, from the wrong side of the placemat to the top. Use the hook to grab one strand of each of the four colors of yarn.
- 2. Use the hook to pull the yarn through the stitch.

3. Cut the yarn, approximately 2 1/2 inches [6 cm] from the loop



4. Feed the ends of the yarn through the loop



5. Pull the loop tight.

Trim fringe if desired.
