# LION BRAND CHENILLE THICK & QUICK® WRAP

# Item #992A

## SIZES:

Directions are for size Medium/Large (X-Large). Width across Back: 39" (42"). Length: 32" (35").

# **MATERIALS:**

- LION BRAND Chenille Thick & Quick, Art. No. 950, 8 (10) skeins #136 Russet or solid color of your choice. Note: Solid colors come in 100 yd skeins; Prints are 75 yds.
- Crochet hook size N U.S. (00 U.K.) (9.00 mm)
  OR SIZE NEEDED TO OBTAIN GAUGE.

### GAUGE:

5 sts + 4 rows = 4" in hdc on size N hook. TO INSURE PROPER SIZE, BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

### NOTE:

Wrap is worked side-to-side.

## **BACK:**

Ch 43 (47).

Row 1: Hdc in 3rd ch from hook and in each ch across – 40 (44) hdc. Ch 2, turn. Row 2: Hdc in each hdc across. Ch 2, turn. Rep Row 2 until piece measures 39" (42") from beg. Fasten off.

# **RIGHT FRONT:**

Work same as Back until piece measures 16" (17") from beg. Mark last row worked for WS. **Shape neck: Next row (RS):** Hdc across to last 4 sts (leaving last 4 sts unworked). Ch 2, turn. **Next row (WS):** Hdc across. Ch 2, turn. Rep last 2 rows always leaving 4 neck sts unworked at end of every RS row until piece measures 20" (22") from beg. Fasten off.

#### LEFT FRONT:

Work same as Right Front to neck shaping. **Shape neck: Next row (RS):** SI st across first 4 sts, hdc to end of row. Ch 2, turn. **Next row:** Hdc across. Ch 2, turn. Rep last 2 rows always working sI st across first 4 sts on every RS row until piece measures 20" (22") from beg. Fasten off.

#### FINISHING:

SI st or sew shoulder seams. Starting at shoulder seam, work 1 row sc around entire piece. Ch 1, do not turn. Work 1 row rev sc, working from left to right, around entire piece. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

#### **ABBREVIATIONS:**

beg = begin(ning)

ch = chain

hdc = half double crochet

rep = repeat

rev sc = reverse single crochet

RS = right side

sc = single crochet

sl st = slip stitch

st(s) = stitch(es)

WS = wrong side
