



LION BRAND® JIFFY THICK & QUICK® FUN FUR Bag in a Jiffy



The combination of Jiffy Thick & Quick and Fun Fur Yarns makes this a striking bag you can knit in a day.
Featured in Jiffy Rocky Mountains

Skill Level: Beginner

SIZE

9 ½" x 10"

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND Jiffy Thick & Quick
1 ball #208 Rocky Mountains or color of your choice
- LION BRAND Fun Fur
2 balls #113 Red or color of your choice
- One 1" (25 mm) button (optional)

Knit Version

- LION BRAND size 35 (19 mm) knitting needles OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE
- Large-eyed blunt needle

Crochet Version

- LION BRAND size Q-19 (15 mm) crochet hook OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE

KNIT VERSION

GAUGE

6 stitches + 8 rows = 4" (10 cm) in stockinette stitch (knit on right side, purl on wrong side).
BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE

NOTE

Bag is worked with 1 strand of Jiffy Thick & Quick and 2 strands of Fun Fur held together throughout.

PURSE

Cast on 15 stitches. Work 2 rows in Garter stitch (knit every row). Work in stockinette stitch until piece measures 18" from beginning, ending with a purl row. Work 2 rows Garter stitch. Bind off all stitches.

FINISHING

Fold piece in half and sew side seams.

STRAP

Cast on 40 sts. Next Row. Bind off all stitches. Attach strap to side seams at top of purse. Weave in loose ends.

Optional

Sew on button if desired. Insert through fabric for buttonhole.

CROCHET VERSION

GAUGE

4.5 stitches + 5 rows = 4" (10 cm) in single crochet.
BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

NOTE

Bag is worked with 1 strand of Jiffy Thick & Quick and 2 strands of Fun Fur held together throughout.

PURSE

Chain 12. Single crochet in 2nd chain from hook and in each chain across. Chain 1, turn.

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Row 1 Single crochet in each single crochet across. Chain 1, turn.
Repeat Row 1 until piece measures 19". Do not fasten off.

FINISHING

Fold Purse in half and join corners by making a slip stitch through both thicknesses. Chain 36". Slip stitch through both corners at opposite side of Purse. Break off both Fun Fur strands and, continuing with Jiffy Thick & Quick only, slip stitch through both thicknesses down side seam of Purse (you may wish to use a somewhat smaller size hook for this). Fasten off. Join Jiffy Thick & Quick to opposite side of Purse and slip stitch second side seam. Fasten off and weave in ends.

Purse may be used on this side with slip stitching as decorative seam or turned to the other side for a smooth look.

Optional

Sew on button if desired. Insert through fabric for buttonhole.
