EASY**SIZE XS (S, M, L, 1X, 2X, 3X)**

Finished Chest 37 (40, 43, 46, 49, 52, 55)"

Note: Before beginning pattern, circle all numbers pertaining to your size for ease in working.

MATERIALS**• LION BRAND Cotton-Ease**

5 (6, 6, 7, 7, 8, 8) balls #113 Cherry Red or color of your choice

• Size 7 (4.5 mm) and 8 (5 mm) knitting needles OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE**• Large-eyed, blunt needle****GAUGE****• 18 sts + 27 rows = 4" (10 cm) in St st (k on RS, p on WS) on smaller needles.****• 23 sts + 24 rows = 4" (10 cm) in Farrow Rib on larger needles.****BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.****PATTERN STITCH**

Farrow Rib (multiple of 3)

Row 1 (WS) K 1, p 1; *k 2, p 1; rep from * to last st, k 1.**Row 2** K 1, *k 2, p 1; rep from *, end k 2.**Rep Rows 1-2** for pattern.**NOTE:** Work all decreases and increases one stitch in from edge.© 2002 **Lion Brand Yarn Company**, all rights reserved.

BACK

With larger needles, cast on 105 (114, 123, 132, 141, 150, 159) sts. Work in Farrow Rib for 5 (5¼, 5½, 6, 6¼, 6½, 7)", ending with a WS row. With smaller needles, knit next row, dec 20 (22, 24, 26, 28, 30, 32) sts evenly spaced across row – 85 (92, 99, 106, 113, 120, 127) sts. Knit 1 row. Work in St st until piece measures 16 (16¾, 17, 17¼, 18, 18¼, 18¾)" from beg, ending with a WS row.

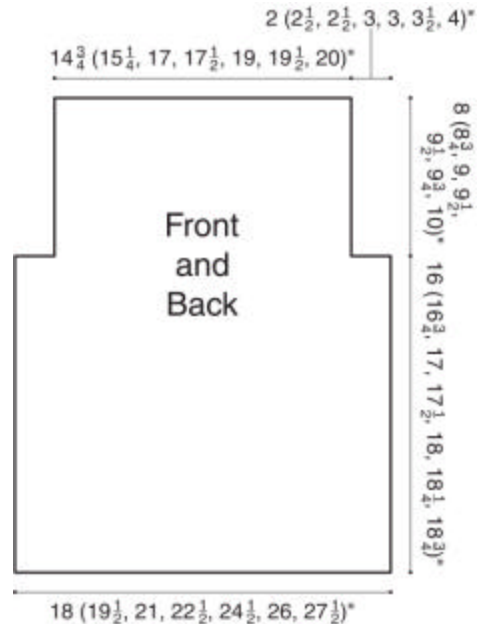
Shape Armhole Bind off 10 (12, 12, 14, 14, 16, 18) sts at beg of next 2 rows – 65 (68, 75, 78, 85, 88, 91) sts. Work even until armhole measures 6 (6¾, 7, 7¼, 7¼, 7¾, 8)", ending with a WS row. Change to larger needles and knit next row, inc 13 (13, 15, 18, 20, 20, 20) sts evenly spaced across row – 78 (81, 90, 96, 105, 108, 111) sts. Knit 1 row. Work Farrow Rib for 12 rows. Bind off in pattern.

FRONT

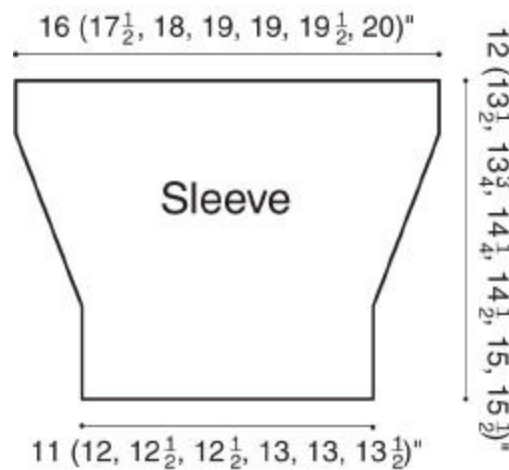
Work same as Back.

SLEEVE

With larger needles, cast on 63 (69, 72, 72, 75, 75, 78) sts. Work in Farrow Rib for 3¼ (4, 4, 4, 4¼, 4¼, 4¼)", ending with a WS row. Change to smaller needles and knit next row, dec 13 (14, 14, 14, 15, 15, 16) sts evenly spaced across row – 50 (55, 58, 58, 60, 60, 62) sts. Knit 1 row. Work in St st, inc 1 st each end every other row 3 (0, 3, 7, 5, 7, 7) times, then every 4th row 9 (11, 10, 8, 9, 8, 8) times – 74 (77, 84, 88, 88, 90, 92) sts. Work even until piece measures 12 (13¼, 13¾, 14¼, 14¼, 15, 15¼)" from beg. Bind off loosely in pattern.

FINISHING

Sew shoulder seams, leaving center 9 (9, 9¼, 9¼, 10, 10, 10)" open on Front and Back for neck. Sew in sleeves. Sew side and sleeve seams. Weave in ends.
