

Free Knitting Pattern Lion Brand® PolarSpun Mother/Daughter Sweaters-Knit: Beginner Pattern Number: 20306



This cuddly duo is easy to make in both child and adult sizes and is a pleasure to wear in soft, lightweight, Polarspun yarn.

SKILL LEVEL: Beginner

SIZE: Child (Multiple Sizes), Adult (Multiple Sizes), Medium

Child 2 yrs (3-4 yrs, 5-6 yrs, 7-8 yrs); Adult S (M,/L, 1X/2X)

Finished Chest 26 (30, 34; 38, 42, 46, 52) inches.

Note: Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

CORRECTIONS: (applied Mar 23, 2013)

SIZES: 24 months (2 yrs), Child 3, Child 4, Child 5-6, Child 7-8, Small, Medium, Large, 1X Child 2 yrs (3-4 yrs, 5-6 yrs, 7-8 yrs); Adult S (M,/L, 1X/2X)

*<u>PolarSpun</u> (Article #360). 100% Polyester; package size: 1.75oz/50.00 gr. (137yds/125m) pull skeins

MATERIALS

- 360-203 <u>Lion Brand PolarSpun</u> yarn: <u>Mango Punch (discontinued)</u>
 3 (4, 4; 5, 6, 7, 8) Balls
- <u>Lion Brand Knitting Needles- Size</u>
 9 [5.5 mm]



GAUGE:

14 sts + 19 rows = 4" (10 cm) in stockinette stitch (knit on right side, purl on wrong side).


BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.


NOTES:

Here and throughout, Child sizes appear first; and are separated by a semi-colon from Adult sizes.

BACK AND FRONT

Cast on 46 (54, 60; 68, 74, 82, 92) sts. Work in stockinette stitch until piece measures 151/2 (161/2, 18; 21, 22, 23, 24)" from beginning. Bind off 6 (8, 9; 7, 8, 9, 10) sts at beginning of next 4 rows, then bind off 0 (0, 0; 6, 6, 7, 9) sts at beginning of following 2 rows. Work 7 rows even in stockinette stitch on remaining 22 (22, 24; 28, 30, 32, 34) sts. Bind off all sts loosely.





SLEEVES

Cast on 24 (26, 28; 30, 34, 34, 36) sts. Work 2" even in stockinette stitch. Increasing 4 (6, 6; 4, 2, 4, 6) sts evenly across next row. Continue to work in stockinette stitch, increasing 1 st each edge every 6th; 5th row 6 (8, 10; 14, 14, 15, 15) times – 40 (48, 54; 62, 64, 68, 72) sts. Work even until Sleeve measures 101/2 (12 1/2, 15, 17, 18, 181/2, 19)" from beginning. Bind off loosely.

FINISHING

Sew shoulder and neck seams. At roll edge of neck, sleeves and body, reverse seam to right side for neater roll. Mark 51/2 (6 3/4, 71/2; 8 3/4, 9, 91/2, 101/4)" down from each shoulder seam. Sew sleeves to body between these markers. Sew side and sleeve seams. Weave in ends.
