GAUGE:

14 dc + 12 rows = 4" (10 cm) with MC. Finished square = 41/4" (11 cm).

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

STITCH EXPLANATION:

sc2tog (sc dec) Insert hook into st and draw up a loop. Insert hook into next st and draw up a loop. Yarn over, draw through all 3 loops on hook.

dc dec Yo and draw up a loop in next space. Yo and draw up a loop in next sc. Yo and draw through 3 loops. (Yo and draw through 2 loops) twice.

Round 5 of all squares is MC.

SQUARE - Make 50 (60) [5 (6) in each color combination listed in chart]

Ch 4, join with slip st to form ring.

Rnd1 Ch3, 4 dc in ring, (ch3,5dc in ring)3 times, ch 3, join with slip st to top of beg ch-3. **Rnd 2** Ch 2, (yo, insert hook in next dc, yo and pull up a loop, yo and pull through 2 loops) 4 times, yo and pull through all 5 loops on hook (*dec made*), ch 4, slip st in next ch-3 space, ch 4, *(yo, insert hook in next dc, yo and pull up a loop, yo and pull through 2 loops) 5 times, yo and pull through all 6 loops on hook (*dec made*), ch 4, slip st in next ch3-space, ch 4. Repeat from * twice more; join with slip st to top of first decrease. Fasten off

Rnd 3 Working over slip st of Rnd 2, join next color yarn with slip st in any ch-3 space of Rnd 1. Ch 3, (2 dc, ch 1, 3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in same space, slip st in top of next dc dec, *working over slip st of Rnd 2, work (3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in next ch-3 space of Rnd 1, slip st in top of next dc dec. Repeat from * twice more; join with slip st to top of beg ch-3. Fasten off.

Rnd 4 Join next color with slip st in any ch2-space. Ch 3, (4 dc, ch 2, 5 dc) in same space, skip next 3 dc, slip st in ch-1 space, skip next 3 dc, 5 dc in next slip st, skip next 3 dc, slip st in next ch-1 space, skip next 3 dc, *(5 dc, ch 2, 5 dc) in next ch-2 space, skip next 3 dc, slip st in next ch-1 space, skip next 3 dc, 5 dc in next slip st, skip next 3 dc, slip st in next ch-1 space, skip next 3 dc. Repeat from * twice more; join with slip st to top of beg ch-3. Fasten off.

Rnd 5 Join MC with slip st in any ch-2 space. Ch 1, *5 sc in same ch-2 space, (skip next dc, sc in next dc) twice, skip next dc, working over slip st of Rnd 4, dc in next ch-1 space of Rnd 3, skip next 2 dc, 3 sc in next dc, skip next 2 dc, working over slip st of Rnd 4, dc in next ch-1 space of Rnd 3, (skip next dc, sc in next dc) twice, skip next dc. Repeat from * 3 more times; join with slip st to first sc. Fasten off.

ASSEMBLY

With MC, being careful not to place like color squares together, whipstitch squares into 10 (12) strips of 5 squares each. Whipstitch 5 (6) strips together for Front of sweater and 5 (6) strips together for Back of sweater. Each piece will be 5×5 (6×5) squares.

YOKE Note Yoke is worked at top of Front piece, then repeated for Back piece. With MC and RS facing, draw up a loop in 3rd corner st at top of Front or Back.

Row 1 (RS) Ch 1, sc in each st across top of each square – 13 sc, and work hdc in st before and after each seam, turn – 73 (88) sts.

Row 2 (WS) Ch 1, sc in first sc, *ch 1, skip next st, sc in next st. Repeat from * across, ending ch 1, skip next st, sc (sc2tog) in last 1 (2) sts – 73 (87) sts. Fasten off. With G and RS facing, draw up a loop in first sc.

Row3 (RS) Ch1, sc in each sc and in each ch-1 space across. Fasten off. With MC and RS facing, draw up a loop in first sc.

Row 4 (RS) Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Row 5 (WS) Ch 1, sc in first sc, *ch 1, skip next st, sc in next st. Repeat from * across. Fasten off. With H and RS facing, draw up a loop in first sc.

Row 6 (RS) Ch 2, hdc in each sc and in each ch-1 space across. Fasten off. With MC and RS facing, draw up a loop in first hdc.

Row 7 (RS) Ch 1, sc in each hdc across, turn.

Row 8 (WS) Repeat Row 5. Fasten off.

Row 9 (RS) With I, repeat Row 3. Fasten off.


Row 10 (RS) With MC, repeat Row 4.

Row 11 (WS) Ch 1, sc in first sc, *ch 1, skip next st, sc in next st. Repeat from * 7 (10) more times, ch 1, skip next st, sc (sc2tog) in next 1(2) sts, turn – 9 (12) ch-1 spaces.

Row 12 (RS) Ch 3 (counts as first dc), dc dec through next ch-1 space and next sc, [dc in next ch1-space and in next sc] twice, [hdc in next ch-1 space and in next sc] 2 (3) times, [sc in next ch-1 space and in next sc] 2 (3) times, slip st in remaining sc and ch-1 spaces. Fasten off, leaving a long tail on Front for sewing. (No tail is needed on Back.) On opposite side of piece (other shoulder), with MC and WS facing, draw up a loop in 19th (26th) sc to the right of Sleeve edge.

Row 11 (WS) Sc (sc2tog) in first 1 (2) sts, *ch 1, skip next st, sc in next st. Repeat from * 8 (11) more times, turn – 9 (12) ch-1 spaces.

Row 12 (RS) [Slip st in sc and in next ch1-space] 2 (3) times, [sc in next sc and in next ch-1 space] 2 (3) times, [hdc in next sc and in next ch-1 space] 2 (3) times, [dc in next sc and in next ch-1 space] twice, dc in next sc, dc dec through last ch-1 space and last sc. Fasten off, leaving a long tail on Front for sewing.



SLEEVES

With MC, ch 36 (38).

Row 1 (RS) Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn - 35 (37) sc.

Row 2 Ch 1, sc in first sc, *ch 1, skip next st, sc in next st. Repeat from * across. Fasten off.

Rows 3-10 Repeat Rows 3-10 of Yoke, working Row 3 with J, Row 6 with A, Row 9 with B, and all other rows with MC.

Note Work remainder of Sleeve through front loop only of each st.

Rows 11-15 Ch 1, sc in each sc across.

Row16 Ch1, 2 sc in first sc, * sc in eacho fn ext 16 (17) sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from * – 38 (40) sc.

Rows 17-33 Repeat Row 11.

Row34 Ch1, 2 sc in first sc, * sc in eacho fn ext 17 (18) sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from *, sc in last sc - 41 (43) sc.

Rows 35-38 Repeat Row 11.

Row39 Ch1,1(2) sc in first sc, * sc in each of next 19 (20) sc, 1(2) sc in next sc;r epeat from * – 41 (46) sc.

Rows 40-43 Repeat Row 11.

Row 44 Ch1, 2 sc in first sc, * sc in each of next 19 (21) sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeatf rom *, sc in last 0 (1) sc - 44 (49) sc.

Rows 45-49 Repeat Row 11.

Row 50 Ch1, 2 sc in first sc, * sc in each of next 20 (23) sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from *, sc in last 1 (0) sc - 47 (52) sc.

Row 51 Repeat Row 11. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. With RS facing and MC, draw up a loop in 4th (5th) sc of Row 51.

Row 52 Ch1, sc in same sc and in next 40 (43) sc, turn-41 (44) sc.

Row 53 Slip st in first 2 sc. Ch 1, sc2tog, sc across to last 4 sts, sc2tog, turn – 35 (38) sc.

Row 54 Repeat Row 53 - 29 (32) sc.

Row 55 Ch 1, sc2tog, sc across, sc2tog, turn. Repeat Row 55 until 3 (4) sc remain. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

FINISHING Seam shoulders With tails of MC and RS facing, sew tog shoulder seams using a whipstitch through front loops of sts.]

Neckline Trim With MC, draw up a loop in first sc on back right hand edge of neck.


Rnd 1 Ch1, * sc in each of next 35 sc across Back, sc in end of next sc row, sc in bottom and top of next dc row, 2 sc in seam, sc in top and bottom of dc row, sc in end of next sc row. Repeat from * once more. Join with slip st to beg sc - 86 sc.

Rnd 2 Ch1,(sc, ch2 ,sc) in first sc, * ch 1, skip 2 sc, (sc, ch2,sc) in next sc. Repeat from * around, ending ch 1, skip last sc, join to beg sc. Fasten off.

Sleeve Seam With tail of yarn from Row 51 and RS facing, sew Sleeve seam using a whipstitch through st loops at ends of rows.

Sleeve Trim With MC, draw up a loop in seam.

Rnd1 Ch1,(sc,ch2,sc) in seam, * ch1 ,skip 2 ch, (sc, ch2 ,sc) in next ch. Repeat from * around, ending ch 1, skip last 2 (1) ch, join to beg sc. Fasten off. With tail of yarn at top of Sleeve, sew Sleeves into arm openings using a whipstitch through ends of rows of Sleeves and sts of squares and yoke. Sew side seam, leaving bottom square unsewn for side vent. Weave in ends.
