There's nothing old-fashioned about this hip take on the shawl. Granny squares in hot hues create a pretty pattern, fun fringe finishes the look.

Finished measurements 67 inches x 19 inches uses 2 skeins Homespun* Antique #307 and 1 skein each Boston Rose #371, Coral Gables #370, Boroque #322 and Gothic #334. Exclusive.

Requires size N-13(9mm) hook.

GAUGE:

One square = 6" (15 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

BPdc (back post dc): Yo, working from back to front to back, insert hook around post of st of row below, yo and draw up a loop, (yo and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice. Skip st in front of the BPdc.

FPdc (front post dc) Yo, working from front to back to front, insert hook around post of st of row below, yo and draw up a loop, (yo and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice. Skip st behind the FPdc.

SHAWL

Shawl consists of 33 squares. There are 13 Solid squares: 1 of A, and 3 each of B, C, D, and E. There are 20 bi-color squares (Rows 1-2 in first color and Rows 3-4 in second color): 1 each of AB, AC, AD, AE, BA, BC, BD, BE, CA, CB, CD, CE, DA, DB, DC, DE, EA, EB, EC, and ED.

NOTES:

Editor's Note: When creating fringe using Homespun please note that because of the texture of the yarn the

fringe will fray when cut. If you prefer a non-frayed look you can knot the ends, knit or crochet a fringe, or use hairspray or fray check.

SQUARES – Make 33

Ch 4, join with slip st to form ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 3 – counts as first dc throughout, 11 dc into ring, join with slip st to top of beg ch-3 – 12 dc.

Rnd 2: Ch 3, FPdc around ch-3 of Rnd 1, (BPdc then FPdc around next dc of Rnd 1) 11 times, join with slip st to top of beg ch-3 – 24 dc. If changing color, fasten off and join new color in same st.

Rnd 3: Ch 6, dc in same st – first corner made, *(ch 1, skip next dc, dc in next dc) twice, ch 1, skip next dc, (dc, ch 3, dc) in next dc – 2nd corner made, repeat from * twice more, (ch 1, skip next dc, dc in next dc) twice, ch 1, skip next dc, join with slip st to 3rd ch of beg ch-6.

Rnd 4: Slip st into ch3-space, (ch 3, 2 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in same ch-space, *(ch 1, skip next dc, dc in next ch-1 space) 3 times, ch 1, skip next dc, (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in next ch-3 space, repeat from * twice more, (ch 1, skip next dc, dc in next ch1-space) 3 times, ch 1, skip next dc, join with slip st to top of beg ch-3. Fasten off, leaving long (12”) tail for sewing.

ASSEMBLY

Arrange squares and sew together into 3 rows of 11 squares each, taking care not to put too many like-colored squares together. Sew 3 strips together.

BORDER

Rnd 1: Join A in any corner ch-3 space, sc in each sc and ch-space around, working 3 sc in each corner space. Join with slip st to beg sc.

Rnd 2: Sc in each sc along long ends of Shawl and work Chain Loop Fringe across short ends. Join with slip st to beg sc. Fasten off.

CHAIN LOOP FRINGE

Sc in first st, *ch 16, slip st in 2nd ch from hook and each of next 14 ch, slip st in same sc where ch begins and in next 2 sc; repeat from * across, ending ch 16, slip st in 2nd ch from hook and each of next 14 ch, slip st in same sc where ch begins, sc in last sc.
