* $\underline{Incredible}$ ® (Article #520). 100% Nylon; package size: 1.75oz/50.00 gr. (110yds/100m) pull skeins

MATERIALS

- 520-206 <u>Lion Brand Incredible Yarn:</u> <u>Autumn Leaves</u>
 2 Balls
- <u>Lion Brand Crochet Hook Size K-10.5</u> (6.5 mm)



GAUGE:

15 ch = 4'' (10 cm).

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

STITCH EXPLANATION:

JC (joining cluster) Slip st in specified ch, ch 1, (yo, insert hook in same ch and draw up a loop, yo and draw through 2 loops on hook) 3 times, yo and draw through all 4 loops on hook.

NOTES:

When starting and ending each Strip, leave a tail of yarn about 12" long for fringe. When joining chains, always start at front and work towards back.

STRIP 1

Ch 104. Fasten off. Mark beginning of this chain as front.

STRIP 2

Ch 8, JC in 4th ch of Strip 1, (ch 11, skip next 11 ch of Strip 1, JC in next ch of Strip 1) 8 times, ch 9. Fasten off.

STRIP 3

Ch 3, JC in 4th ch of Strip 2, ch 9, skip next 4 ch, JC and 5 ch of Strip 2, JC in next ch of Strip 2, (ch 11, skip next 5 ch, JC and 5 ch of Strip 2, JC in next ch of Strip 2) 8 times, ch 4. Fasten off.

STRIP 4

Ch 8, skip first 3 ch, JC, and 3 ch of Strip 3, JC in next ch of Strip 3, (ch 11, skip next 5 ch, JC and 5 ch of Strip 3, JC in next ch of Strip 3) 8 times, ch 9. Fasten off.

STRIP 5

Work as for Strip 3, joining to Strip 4 instead of Strip 2.

STRIP 6

Work as for Strip 4, joining to Strip 5 instead of Strip 3.

STRIP 7

Work as for Strip 3, joining to Strip 6 instead of Strip 2.

STRIP 8

Work as for Strip 4, joining to Strip 7 instead of Strip 3.

STRIP 9

Work as for Strip 3, joining to Strip 8 instead of Strip 2.

STRIP 10

Ch 58, JC in 56th ch of Strip 9, (ch 11, skip next 5 ch, JC and 5 ch of Strip 9, JC in next ch of Strip 9) 4 times, ch 9. Fasten off.

STRIP 11

Ch 3, JC in 4th ch of Strip 10, (ch 11, skip next 11 ch of Strip 10, JC in next ch of Strip 10) 4 times, (ch 11, skip next 5 ch, JC, and 5 ch of Strip 10, JC in next ch of Strip 10) 5 times, ch 4. Fasten off.

STRIP 12

Ch 8, skip first 3 ch, JC, and 5 ch of Strip 11, JC in next ch of Strip 11, (ch 11, skip next 5 ch, JC and 5 ch of Strip 11, JC in next ch of Strip 11) 8 times, ch 9. Fasten off.

STRIP 13

Ch 3, JC in 4th ch of Strip 12, ch 9, skip next 4 ch, JC and 5 ch of Strip 12, JC in next ch of Strip 12, (ch 11, skip next 5 ch, JC and 5 ch of Strip 12, JC in next ch of Strip 12) 8 times, ch 4. Fasten off.

STRIP 14

Work as for Strip 12, joining to Strip 13 instead of Strip 11.

STRIP 15

Work as for Strip 13, joining to Strip 14 instead of Strip 12.

STRIP 16

Work as for Strip 12, joining to Strip 15 instead of Strip 11.

STRIP 17

Work as for Strip 13, joining to Strip 16 instead of Strip 12.

STRIP 18

Ch 3, skip first 3 ch, JC, and 3 ch of Strip 17, JC in next ch of Strip 17, (ch 11, skip next 5 ch, JC and 5 ch of Strip 17, JC in next ch of Strip 17) 8 times, ch 4. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Trim front and back fringe evenly.
