

LION BRAND® FUN FUR & WOOL-EASE® Knit Dog Fur Coat



Skill Level: Intermediate

SIZE

S (M, L, X-Large)

Chest measurement 14 (18, 22, 26)"

Finished sweater measurement 15 (19, 23, 27)"

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND Fun Fur
- 1 (1, 2, 2) balls #134 Copper (MC1)
- 1 (1, 2, 2) balls #126 Chocolate (MC2) or colors of your choice
- LION BRAND Wool-Ease
- 1 (1, 2, 2) balls #125 Camel (CC) or color of your choice
- LION BRAND Size 10.5 (6.5 mm) knitting needles OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE
- LION BRAND Size 9 (5.5 mm) knitting needles
- LION BRAND Size 9 (5.5mm) double-pointed needles (set of 5)
- Large-eyed blunt needle

GAUGE

14 sts + 18 rows = 4" (10 cm) in St st (k on RS, p on WS) with one strand each MC and CC held tog on larger needles. 18 sts + 24 rows = 4" (10 cm) in St st with one strand CC on smaller needles. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.


STRIPE SEQUENCE


10 rows MC2, 10 rows MC1.

BACK

Beg at neck opening with one strand each MC2 and CC held tog and larger needles, cast on 40 (54, 68, 72) sts. Work St st in Stripe Sequence until piece measures 8 (12, 16, 17)" from beg, ending with a WS row.

Decrease 1 st each edge every other row 8 (8, 12, 12) times – 24 (38, 44, 48) sts. Work even until piece measures 12 (16, 21, 23)" from beg. Bind off all sts loosely.





UNDERPANEL

Beg at neck opening with one strand CC and smaller needles, cast on 7 sts. Work in K1, P1 Rib, increasing 1 st each end every 3rd row 7 (9, 13, 16) times – 21 (25, 33, 39) sts. Work even until piece measures 8 (12, 16, 17)" from beg. Bind off all sts loosely.

FINISHING

Sew Underpanel to Back leaving a 2 (2½, 3, 3½)" space on each side for front leg openings at the widest point of Underpanel.

Neck

With double-pointed needles and one strand CC, pick up and knit 44 (58, 72, 76) sts evenly around neck opening. Place marker, join, and work in K1, P1 Rib for 3" or desired length. Bind off all sts loosely.

Leg Openings

With double-pointed needles and one strand CC, pick up and knit 20 (22, 24, 26) sts evenly around opening. Place marker, join, and work 5 rnds in K1, P1 Rib. Bind off all sts loosely.

Body Ribbing

With double-pointed needles and one strand CC, pick up and knit 78 (96, 120, 130) sts evenly around Back opening. Join and work 5 rnds K1, P1 Rib. Bind off all sts loosely.

Weave in ends.
