SKILL LEVEL *Intermediate***SIZE**

S (M, L)

Finished chest 40 (44, 48)''**Length** **Shorter Version** 20½ (21, 21½)'' **Longer Version** 26½ (27, 27½)''

Note Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. For ease in working, circle all numbers pertaining to your size.

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND Wool-Ease

Shorter Version

4 (5, 6) balls #153 Black

Longer Version

5 (6, 7) balls #153 Black

or color of your choice

- LION BRAND Fun Fur

Shorter Version

9 (10, 12) balls #153 Black

9 (10, 12) balls #126 Chocolate

Longer Version

11 (12, 14) balls #153 Black

11 (12, 14) balls #126 Chocolate

or colors of your choice

- Size 11 (8 mm) 29'' (80 cm) circular needle OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE
- Size L-11 (8 mm) crochet hook
- Stitch markers
- Stitch holders
- LION BRAND large-eyed, blunt needle

GAUGE

12 sts + 14 rows = 4'' (10 cm) in Rib Pattern with one strand of each yarn held together.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.**PATTERN STITCH**

Rib Pattern (multiple of 3 sts + 1)

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Row 1 (WS) K 1, (p 2, k 1) across.

Row 2 (RS) P 1, (k 2, p 1) across.

Repeat Rows 1-2 for pattern.

NOTE

Body is worked in one piece, then separated at armholes for Back and two Fronts. Use circular needle as if it were separate straight needles and work all parts back-and-forth to produce flat pieces. Work with one strand of each yarn (3 strands total) held together throughout.

BODY

With 1 strand of each yarn held tog, cast on 121 (133, 145) sts.

Work Rib Pattern for 2 rows, placing st marker after st 30 (33, 36) and after st 91 (100, 109) to mark for "side seams."

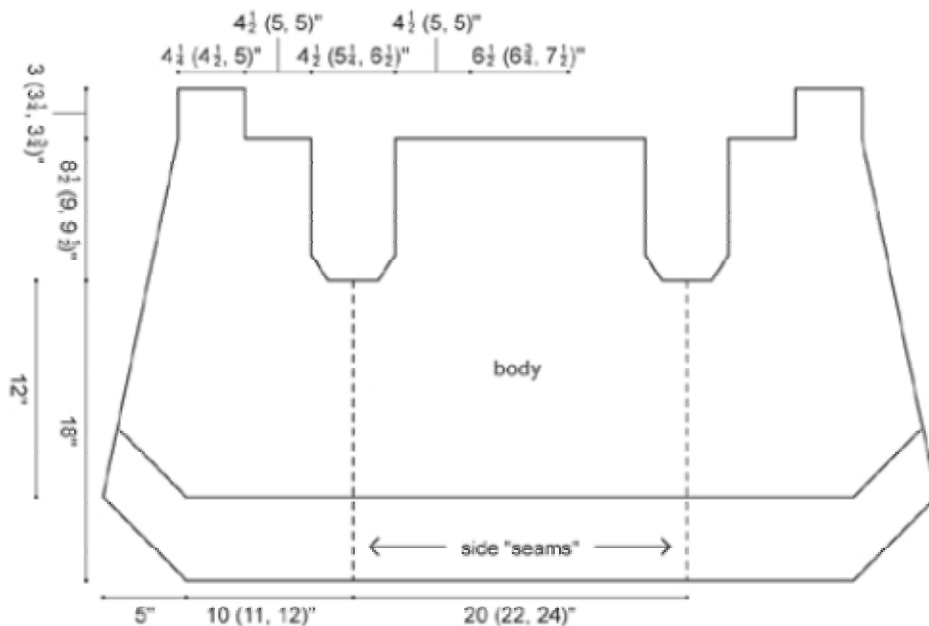
Increase for Collar Cast on 2 sts at beg of next 14 rows for shorter version, next 16 rows for longer version, working increased sts into Rib Pattern – 149 (161, 173) sts for shorter version, 153 (165, 177) sts for longer version.

Decrease Collar Continue in Rib Pattern, dec 1 st at each end every 6th row 10 times for shorter version, 12 times for longer version – 129 (141, 153) sts.

AT SAME TIME, when piece measures 12" for shorter version, 18" for longer version, ending with a WS row, begin armhole shaping.

Shape Armholes Continuing in Rib Pattern, *work to 4 (4, 5) sts from marker, bind off next 8 (8, 10) sts for underarm; repeat from * once more, work to end of row – 53 (58, 63) sts for Back, 30 (33, 35) sts for each Front.

Place sts of both Fronts onto stitch holders.



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BACK

With WS facing, join yarns to Back. Work in Rib Pattern, dec 1 st at each end of every RS row, working dec 1 st from edge, 3 (4, 5) times total – 47 (50, 53) sts. Work even until armholes measure 8½ (9, 9½)". Bind off.

LEFT FRONT

Slip Left Front sts onto needle. With WS facing, join yarns and work in Rib Pattern. Continue to dec for Collar and, AT SAME TIME, dec 1 st at beg of every RS row, working dec 1 st from edge, 3 (4, 5) times total – 27 (29, 30) sts. Work even until armhole measures 8½ (9, 9½)". Bind off 14 (15, 15) sts of shoulder.

Collar Extension On remaining 13 (14, 15) sts of Collar, work even in Rib Pattern for 3 (3¼, 3¾)". Bind off.

RIGHT FRONT

Slip Right Front sts onto needle. With WS facing, join yarns. Work as for Left Front, reversing shaping.

SLEEVES

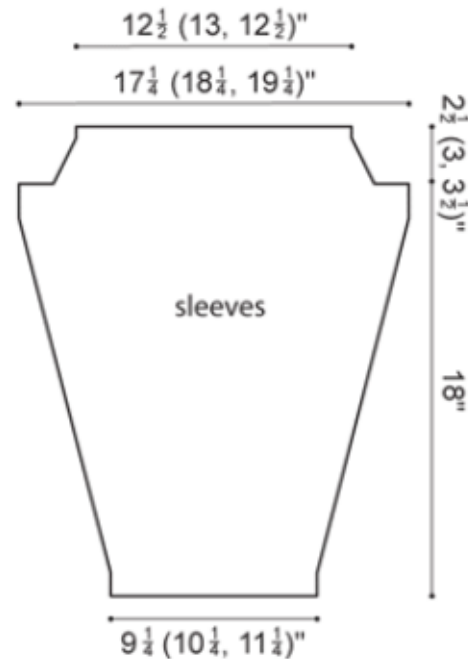
With 1 strand of each yarn held tog, cast on 28 (31, 34) sts.

Work Rib Pattern and inc 1 st at each end of every 4th row 7 times, then every 6th row 5 times, working inc 1 st from edge – 52 (55, 58) sts.

Work even until piece measures 18" from beg, ending with a WS row.

Shape Cap Bind off 4 (4, 5) sts at beg of next 2 rows – 44 (47, 48) sts.

Next Row (RS) Dec 1 st at each end of every RS row, working dec 1 st from edge, 3 (4, 5) times total – 38 (39, 38) sts. Work even until cap measures 2½ (3, 3½)". Bind off.

FINISHING

Sew shoulder seams. Sew in sleeves. Sew sleeve seams.

Sew ends of collar extension tog; sew side edge of collar extension to Back neck.

With RS facing and crochet hook, single crochet evenly around all edges.
