



LION BRAND® HOMESPUN® / FUN FUR Knit Homespun Coat



Combat the cold without sacrificing your sense of chic in this Fur-Fur-trimmed coat of many colors.

SKILL LEVEL: Intermediate**SIZE**

S (M, L, 1X)

Finished chest 39¾ (45¾, 50¼, 55¾)" [101 (116, 127.5, 141.5) cm]**Length** 28½ (29, 29½, 30)" [72.5 (73.5, 75, 76) cm]

Note Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. For ease in working, circle all numbers pertaining to your size.

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND Homespun
 - 1 skein #302 Colonial (A)
 - 2 skeins #318 Sierra (B)
 - 1 (1, 1, 2) skeins #326 Ranch (C)
 - 1 (1, 1, 2) skeins #321 Williamsburg (D)
 - or colors of your choice
- LION BRAND Fun Fur
 - 2 (2, 3, 3) balls #124 Champagne
 - 2 (2, 3, 3) balls #134 Copper
 - or colors of your choice
- LION BRAND size 9 (5.5 mm) knitting needles OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE
- Stitch holders
- LION BRAND large-eyed, blunt needle

GAUGE

12 sts + 24 rows = 4" (10 cm) in garter st (k every row) with Homespun.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

BACK

With A, cast on 76 (84, 92, 100) sts. Work in garter st for 1¾", ending with a WS row.

Next Row (RS) Change to B and work in garter st for 38 rows, dec 1 st each end every 8th row 4 times – 68 (76, 84, 92) sts.**Next Row (RS)** Change to C and knit one row.**Next Row (WS)** *K 3, p 1; repeat from * across row.

Repeat these 2 rows for pattern, dec 1 st each end every 8th row 3 times – 62 (70, 78, 86) sts. Work even in pattern until a total of 30 rows of C have been worked.

Next Row (RS) Change to D and knit one row.**Next Row (WS)** K 2, p 1, *k 3, p 1; repeat from * to last 3 sts, k 3.

Repeat these 2 rows for pattern, dec 1 st each end every 8th row 3 times – 56 (64, 72, 80) sts. Work even in pattern until a total of 28 rows of D have been worked.

Next Row (RS) Change to A and work even in garter st for 14 rows, ending with a WS row.

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Shape Armhole Bind off 5 sts at beg of next 2 rows, then dec 1 st at beg of next 10 rows – 36 (44, 52, 60) sts.

Next Row (RS) Change to B and knit one row.

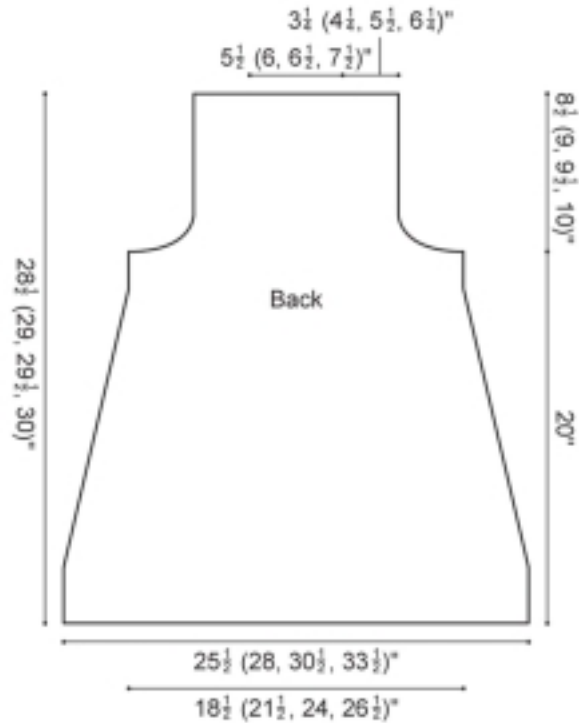
Next Row (WS) *K 3, p 1; repeat from * across row.

Repeat these 2 rows 4 more times (a total of 10 rows).

Next Row (RS) Knit.

Next Row (WS) K 1, p 1, *k 3, p 1; repeat from * to last 2 sts, k 2.

Repeat these 2 rows 4 more times (a total of 10 rows). Repeat last 20 rows for pattern, working until armhole measures 8½ (9, 9½, 10)". Bind off all sts.



LEFT FRONT

With A, cast on 40 (44, 48, 52) sts. Work in garter st for 1¾", ending with a WS row.

Next Row (RS) Change to B and work in garter st for 38 rows, dec 1 st at outside edge (beg of RS rows) every 8th row 4 times – 36 (40, 44, 48) sts.

Next Row (RS) Change to C and knit one row.

Next Row (WS) *K 3, p 1; repeat from * across row.

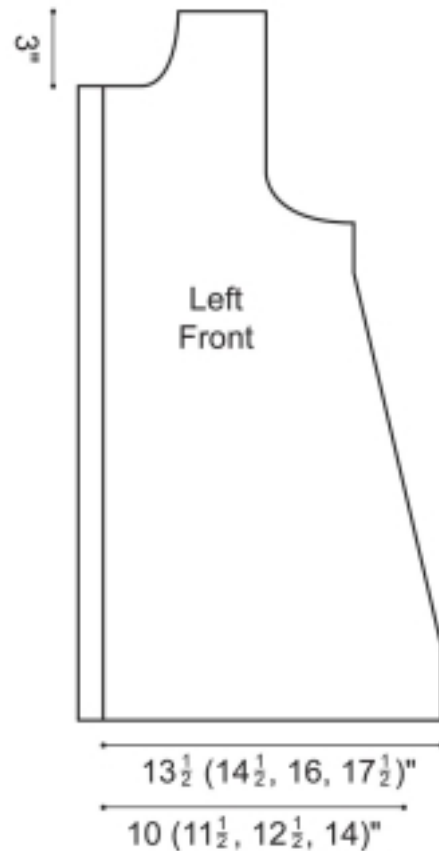
Repeat these 2 rows for pattern, dec 1 st at outside edge every 8th row 3 times – 33 (37, 41, 45) sts. Work even in pattern until a total of 30 rows of C have been worked.

Next Row (RS) Change to D and knit 1 row.

Next Row (WS) K 1, p 1, *k 3, p 1; repeat from * to last 3 sts, k 3.

Repeat these 2 rows for pattern, dec 1 st at outside edge every 8th row 3 times – 30 (34, 38, 42) sts. Work even in pattern until a total of 28 rows of D have been worked.

Next Row (RS) Change to A and work even in



garter st for 14 rows, ending with a WS row.

Shape Armhole Bind off 5 sts at beg of row (outside edge), then dec 1 st from armhole edge every other row 5 times – 20 (24, 28, 32) sts.

Next Row (RS) Change to B and knit 1 row.

Next Row (WS) *K 3, p 1; repeat from * across row.

Repeat last 2 rows 4 more times (a total of 10 rows).

Next Row (RS) Knit.

Next Row (WS) K 1, p 1, *k 3, p 1; repeat from * to last 2 sts, k 2.

Repeat these 2 rows 4 more times (a total of 10 rows). Repeat last 20 rows for pattern, working until armhole measures 5½ (6, 6½, 7)”, ending with a RS row.

Shape Neck Bind off 4 (5, 6, 7) sts at beg of row (neck edge), then continue to bind off and dec every other row (from neck edge) 2 sts once, then 1 st 4 times. When armhole measures same length as Back armhole, bind off remaining 10 (13, 16, 19) sts.

RIGHT FRONT

With A, cast on 40 (44, 48, 52) sts. Work in garter st for 1¾”, ending with a WS row.

Next Row (RS) Change to B and work in garter st for 38 rows, dec 1 st at outside edge (beg of WS rows) every 8th row 4 times – 36 (40, 44, 48) sts.

Next Row (RS) Change to C and knit 1 row.

Next Row (WS) *K 3, p 1; repeat from * across row.

Repeat these 2 rows for pattern, dec 1 st at outside edge every 8th row 3 times – 33 (37, 41, 45) sts. Work even in pattern until a total of 30 rows of C have been worked.

Next Row (RS) Change to D and knit 1 row.

Next Row (WS) K 2, p 1, *k 3, p 1; repeat from * to last 2 sts, k 2.

Repeat these 2 rows for pattern, dec 1 st at outside edge every 8th row 3 times – 30 (34, 38, 42) sts. Work even in pattern until a total of 28 rows of D have been worked.

Next Row (RS) Change to A and work even in garter st for 15 rows, ending with a RS row.

Shape Armhole Bind off 5 sts at beg of row (outside edge), then dec 1 st from armhole edge every other row 5 times – 20 (24, 28, 32) sts.

Next Row (RS) Change to B and knit 1 row.

Next Row (WS) *K 3, p 1; repeat from * across row.

Repeat last 2 rows 4 more times (a total of 10 rows).

Next Row (RS) Knit.

Next Row (WS) K 1, p 1, *k 3, p 1; repeat from * to last 2 sts, k 2.

Repeat these 2 rows 4 more times (a total of 10 rows). Repeat last 20 rows for pattern, working until armhole measures 5½ (6, 6½, 7)”, ending with a WS row.

Shape Neck Bind off 4 (5, 6, 7) sts at beg of row (neck edge), then continue to bind off and dec every other row (from neck edge) 2 sts once, then 1 st 4 times. When armhole measures same length as Back armhole, bind off remaining 10 (13, 16, 19) sts.

SLEEVES

With A, cast on 24 (28, 32, 36) sts. Work in garter st for 1¾”, ending with a WS row.

Next Row (RS) Change to B and work in garter st for 38 rows, inc 1 st each end every 12th row twice – 28 (32, 36, 40) sts.

Next Row (RS) Change to C and knit 1 row.

Next Row (WS) *K 3, p 1; repeat from * across row. Repeat these 2 rows for pattern, inc 1 st each end every 12th row once – 30 (34, 38, 42) sts.

Next Row (RS) Change to D and knit 1 row.

Next Row (WS) K 2, p 1, *k 3, p 1; repeat from * to last 3 sts, k 3.

Repeat these 2 rows for pattern, inc 1 st each end every 12th row twice – 34 (38, 42, 46) sts. Work even until a total of 28 rows of D have been worked.

Next Row (RS) Change to A and work in garter st, inc 1 st each end every 12th row once – 36 (40, 44, 48) sts. Work 2 more rows even.

Shape Cap Bind off 5 sts at beg of next 2 rows, then dec 1 st at beg of next 10 rows – 16 (20, 24, 28) sts.

Next Row (RS) Change to B and knit 1 row.

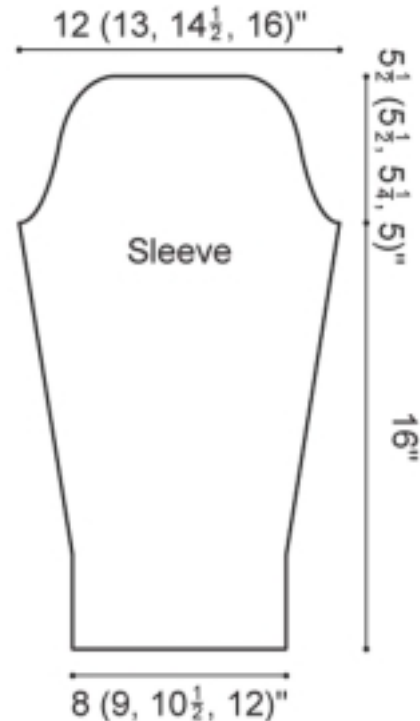
Next Row (WS) K 1, p 1, *k 3, p 1; repeat from * to last 2 sts, k 2.

Repeat last 2 rows 4 more times (a total of 10 rows).

Next Row (RS) Knit.

Next Row (WS) *K 3, p 1; repeat from * across row.

Repeat these 2 rows for pattern, working until piece measures 21½ (21½, 21¼, 21)”. Bind off all sts.



FINISHING

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Sew shoulder seams. Sew in Sleeves. Sew side and Sleeve seams.

Front Trim

With 1 strand of each color of Fun Fur held tog, cast on 7 sts. Work even in garter st for 25½ (26, 26½, 27)". Bind off all sts and sew to Left Front. Repeat for Right Front.

Collar

With 1 strand of each color of Fun Fur held tog, cast on 52 (56, 60, 64) sts. Work 4 rows in garter st. Inc 1 st each end of next row, then every following 8th row 3 more times – 60 (64, 68, 72) sts. Work even until piece measures 6". Bind off all sts and sew around neck.

Fun Fur (Article #320) solid colors are packaged in 1¾ oz (50 g)/60 yd (54 m) balls; Prints are 1½ oz (40 g)/57 yds (52 m)
