SKILL LEVEL: Easy (Level 2)

SIZE: One Size

Hat:

One size fits most (10 inches diameter/32 inches circumference)

Scarf: Measures 8 inches x 96 inches, unfinished

CORRECTIONS: (applied Jul 17, 2004)

Scarf Size: 8" x 76" SCARF With K hook, ch 21. Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across - 20 sc. Row 1 Ch 1, turn. Sc in each sc across. Repeat Row 1 for 76".

MATERIALS

790-336 <u>Lion Brand</u>
 <u>Homespun Yarn: Barrington</u>

 4 Balls

*Homespun® (Article #790). 98% Acrylic, 2% Polyester; package size: 6.00oz/170.00 gr. (185yds/169m) pull skeins

- <u>Lion Brand Crochet Hook -</u> <u>Size J-10 (6 mm)</u>
- <u>Lion Brand Crochet Hook -</u> <u>Size K-10.5 (6.5 mm)</u>
- Additional Materials
 Nata: 1 also in in for the second s

Note: 1 skein is for the hat; 3 skeins for the scarf



GAUGE:

Exact gauge is not essential to this project.

BERET

With K hook, ch 4. SI st to form ring.

Rnd 1 6 sc in ring, place marker for beg of rnd.

Rnd 2

Inc 1 st in each st - 12 sc.

Rnd 3 *1 sc in next st, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around - 18 sc.

Rnd 4 *1 sc in each of next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around - 24 sc.

Rnd 5 *1 sc in each of next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around - 30 sc.

Rnds 6 - 13Continue in this manner, working 1 sc more between incs each rnd until there are 78 sts.

Work even on 78 sts for 2 inches. Fasten off.

Ribbing

With J hook, Ch 4. **Row 1** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across - 3 sc. **Row 2** Ch 1, turn, working through back lps only, sc in each sc. Repeat Row 2 for 21 inches stretched.

Finishing

With RS facing, sew short edges of ribbing together invisibly. With RS facing, sew ribbing to Beret, easing in fullness. **Top Knot** With K hook, ch 7, leaving a 3 inches tail on each end of ch. Break yarn, tie ch into a knot and secure at beg ring.

SCARF

With K hook, ch 21. Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across - 20 sc.

Row 1 Ch 1, turn. Sc in each sc across. Repeat Row 1 for 96 inches. Fasten off.

Finishing Laying scarf flat, fold up 8 inches on each end to form pocket. Sew sides in place invisibly.
