This is a great beginning project -- the hotpad is luxuriously thick and won't develop thin spots like store-bought potholders!

#### **MATERIALS**

 760-098 <u>Lion Brand Lion Cotton</u> <u>Yarn: Natural</u>
 1 Ball

<u>Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size K-10.5 (6.5 mm)</u>



#### **GAUGE:**

5 sc = 2 inches; 8 rows = 3 inches.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

**POTHOLDER:** With 3 strands of yarn held together, ch 21.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across (20 sc). Ch 1, turn.

Row 2: Sc in each sc across. Ch 1, turn. Rep Row 2 until piece measures 8" from beg.

Last Row: Sc in each sc across, end (ch 10, sl st in last sc made) for loop. Do not fasten off.

**Edging Row:** Ch 1, sc in same space as last sl st, then sc in each row-end st along the side of potholder to next corner, 3 sc in corner, sc in each st of starting ch to next corner, 3 sc in corner, sc in each row-end st along opposite side edge of potholder. Fasten off.
