SKILL LEVEL: Beginner (Level 1)

SIZE: One Size

Hat: To fit average woman's head.

Scarf: Approx 7½" wide x 72" long.

CORRECTIONS: (applied Nov 19, 2014)

STITCH EXPLANATION:

Hat:

Front post Sc (fpSC) ~~worked on RS rows only:~~ *Insert hook from front-to-back-to-front again around the post of the designated st, yo, draw yarn through st, yo, draw yarn through 2 loops on hook.

HAT: Crown:

Ch 2.

~~Row~~ **Rnd 1 (WS):** Work 9 hdc in 2nd ch from hook; do not join rnds.

~~Row~~ **Rnd 2:** Work 2 hdc in each st around -- 18 hdc.

~~Row~~ **Rnd 3:** Work 2 hdc in each st around -- 36 hdc.

~~Row~~ **Rnd 4:** Hdc in each st around.

~~Row~~ **Rnd 5:** * Hdc in next st, 2 hdc in next st, rep from * around -- 54 hdc.

Sides:

~~Row~~ **Rnd 6 (RS):** Work fpSC in each st around.

~~Row~~ **Rnd 7:** * Dec 1 sc in next 2 sts, sc in next st, rep from * around -- 36 sc.

~~Rows~~ **Rnds 8-10:** Sc in each st around.

~~Row~~ **>Rnd 11:** Sc in each st around, join with sl st to first st. Ch 1, turn.

Brim:

~~Row~~ **Rnd 12 (RS) :** Hdc in each st around, do not join rnds.

~~Row~~ **Rnd 13:** Work fpSC in each st around.

~~Row~~ **Rnd 14:** *Sc in each of next 5 sts, 2 sc in next st, rep from * around -- 42 sts.

~~Row~~ **Rnd 15:** Sc in each st around.

~~Row~~ **Rnd 16:** *Sc in each of next 6 sts, 2 sc in next st, rep from * around -- 48 sc.

~~Row~~ **Rnd 17:** Sc in each st around.

~~Row~~ **Rnd 18:** Loosely sl st in each st around, join with a sl st to first st. Fasten and end off.

MATERIALS

- 950-124 Lion Brand Chenille Thick & Quick Yarn: Khaki
DISCONTINUED
3 Balls

- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size N-13 (9 mm)
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size P-15 (10 mm)

- Additional Materials
Note: Either Hat or Scarf alone takes 2 skeins

For hat
Because of the nature of this yarn, we only give the length, not the weight of the product, as the number of ounces can vary due to the textures of the skein.
For scarf



GAUGE:

Hat:

3 sc = 2"; 3 sc rows = 2" or 1 hdc row = 1".

Scarf:

3 sc = 2"; 8 sc tbl rows = 5".

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch**STITCH EXPLANATION:****Hat:**

Front post Sc (fp_{sc}): *Insert hook from front-to-back-to-front again around the post of the designated st, yo, draw yarn through st, yo, draw yarn through 2 loops on hook.

Dec 1 sc: (Insert hook in next st, yo, draw yarn through st) twice, yo, draw yarn through 3 loops on hook.

Inc 1 sc: Work 2 sc in same st.

Inc 1 hdc: Work 2 hdc in same st.

Scarf:

Sc tbl: single crochet through back loop only.

NOTE: Scarf is worked horizontally from side-to-side along longer edge.

NOTES:

Hat is worked in rnds with WS facing except for the brim. DO NOT JOIN but work in a spiral marking the beg/end of rnd with a smooth contrasting piece of yarn.

HAT**Crown**

Ch 2.

Rnd 1 (WS): Work 9 hdc in 2nd ch from hook; do not join rnds.

Rnd 2: Work 2 hdc in each st around -- 18 hdc.

Rnd 3: Work 2 hdc in each st around -- 36 hdc.

Rnd 4: Hdc in each st around.

Rnd 5: * Hdc in next st, 2 hdc in next st, rep from * around -- 54 hdc.

Sides

Rnd 6: Work fp_{sc} in each st around.

Rnd 7: * Dec 1 sc in next 2 sts, sc in next st, rep from * around -- 36 sc.

Rnds 8-10: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 11: Sc in each st around, join with sl st to first st. Ch 1, turn.

Brim

Rnd 12 (RS): Hdc in each st around, do not join rnds.

Rnd 13: Work fp_{sc} in each st around.

Rnd 14: *Sc in each of next 5 sts, 2 sc in next st, rep from * around -- 42 sts.

Rnd 15: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 16: *Sc in each of next 6 sts, 2 sc in next st, rep from * around -- 48 sc.

Rnd 17: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 18: Loosely sl st in each st around, join with a sl st to first st. Fasten and end off.

SCARF

Loosely ch 109.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each rem ch across -- 108 sc. Ch 1, turn.

Row 2: Sc through both loops of first st, sc tbl of each st across to last st, sc through both loops of last st. Ch 1, turn.

Rows 3-12: Rep Row 2. Fasten off at end of last row.
