

# LION BRAND® CHENILLE THICK & QUICK - HOMESPUN Crochet Long Poncho and Short Poncho



# CROCHET SHORT PONCHO EASY + SIZE

One size

Circumference 32" [81.5 cm] at neck;

57½" [146 cm] at lower edge **Length** 14" [35.5 cm]

## **MATERIALS**

- LION BRAND Chenille Thick & Quick 1 skein #143 Bordeaux (A) or color of your choice
- LION BRAND Homespun 1 skein #366 Metropolis (B) or color of your choice
- LION BRAND size P-15 [10 mm] crochet hook OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE
- LION BRAND size K-10.5 [6.5 mm] crochet hook OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE
- Scraps of contrasting yarn to be used as markers

## **GAUGE**

5 sc = 4" [10 cm] with A on larger hook.

9 sts = 4" [10 cm] in 2dcst with B on smaller hook.

2 rows = 1½" [4 cm] in pattern. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

## STITCH EXPLANATION

2dcst (2 dc stitch) Yo, insert hook in next st and draw up a loop, yo and draw through 2 loops on hook; yo, insert hook in same st and draw up a loop, yo and draw through 2 loops on hook; yo and draw through 3 remaining loops on hook.

#### **NOTES**

To keep track of increases, mark each RS corner space and move the marker up to the WS corner sc each time. Carry unused strand loosely up the WS of work.

#### **PONCHO**

With A and larger hook, loosely ch 40. Join with slip st to form ring, being careful not to twist ch.

Rnd 1 Ch 1, sc in each ch by working into the "nub" or single strand at the back of each ch; join with slip st in beg sc – 40 sc.

Rnd 2 (RS) With B and smaller hook, ch 3, dc in same sc, ch 1, \*(2dcst, ch 1) in next 10 sc, mark space for corner, (2dcst, ch 1) once more in same sc.

Repeat from \* 3 more times, 2dcst in same sc as beg; join with sc in top of beg ch (counts as beg corner space); drop B to back of work, pick up A, ch 1; turn – 44 ch-spaces.

Rnd 3 (WS) With A and larger hook, sc in each ch-space; turn. Keeping strands to back of work, slip st backwards into beg sc of rnd; drop A-44 sc.

Rnd 4 (RS) With B and smaller hook, ch 3, dc in same sc, ch 1, skip slip st, \*(2dcst, ch 1) in each sc to corner sc, (2dcst, ch 1) twice in corner sc. Repeat from \* 3 more times, ending last repeat 2dcst in same sc as beg; join with sc in top of beg ch; drop B to back of work, pick up A, ch 1; turn – 48 ch-spaces.

Rnds 5-16 Repeat Rnds 3-4 for 6 more

times, increasing in pattern as established – 72 ch-spaces.

Rnd 17 (WS) With A and larger hook, sc in each ch-space; join with slip st in beg sc; turn – 72 sc.

Rnd 18 (RS) Ch 1, skip slip st, [sc in each sc to corner sc, 2 sc in corner sc] 4 times, ending last repeat 2 sc in last sc; join with slip st in beg sc.
Fasten off. Weave in ends. To open up the stitch pattern and achieve finished length of 14" [35.5 cm], thoroughly dampen Poncho and spread on clean towel(s) on a carpeted floor or on a bed. Gently ease Poncho into shape, blocking to size, pinning where necessary. Allow to dry completely.

# CROCHET LONG PONCHO EASY + SIZE

One size

Circumference 32" [81.5 cm] at neck:

77" [195.5 cm] at lower edge

**Length** 19" [48.5 cm]

## **MATERIALS**

- LION BRAND Chenille Thick & Quick 2 skeins #133 Eucalyptus (A) or color of your choice
- LION BRAND Homespun 2 skeins #366 Metropolis (B) or color of your choice
- LION BRAND size P-15 [10 mm] crochet hook OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE
- LION BRAND size K-10.5 [6.5 mm] crochet hook OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE
- Scraps of contrasting yarn to be used as markers

## **GAUGE**

5 sc = 4" [10 cm] with A on larger hook.

9 sc = 4" [10 cm] with B on smaller hook.

2 rows =  $1\sqrt{2}$ " [4 cm] in pattern. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

## STITCH EXPLANATION

2dcst (2 dc stitch) Yo, insert hook in next st and draw up a loop, yo and draw through 2 loops on hook; yo, insert hook in same st and draw up a loop, yo and draw through 2 loops on hook; yo and draw through 3 remaining loops on hook.

#### YOKE

With A and larger hook, loosely ch 40. Join with slip st to form ring, being careful not to twist ch.

Rnd 1 Ch 1, sc in each ch by working into the "nub" or single strand at the back of each ch; join with slip st in beg sc – 40 sc.

Rnd 2 Ch 1, sc in same sc, sc in next 8 sc, [2 sc in next sc, sc in next 9 sc] 3 times, 2 sc in last sc; join with slip st in beg sc – 44 sc.

Rnd 3 Ch 1, sc in same sc, sc in next 9 sc, [2 sc in next sc, sc in next 10 sc] 3 times, 2 sc in last sc; join with slip st in beg sc – 48 sc.

Rnd 4 Ch 1, sc in same sc, sc in next 10 sc, [2 sc in next sc, sc in next 11 sc]

3 times, 2 sc in last sc; join with slip st in beg sc – 52 sc.

Rnd 5 Ch 1, sc in same sc, sc in next 11 sc, [2 sc in next sc, sc in next 12 sc] 3 times, 2 sc in last sc; join with slip st in beg sc – 56 sc.

## BODY

**Note** To keep track of increases, mark each RS corner space and move the marker up to the WS corner sc each time. Carry unused strand loosely up the WS of work.

Rnd 6 (RS) With smaller hook, join B in sc before slip st join. Ch 3, dc in same sc, ch 1, \*(2dcst, ch 1) in next 14 sc, mark space for corner, (2dcst, ch 1)

once more in same sc. Repeat from \* 3 more times, ending last repeat 2dcst in same sc as beg; join with sc in top of beg ch *(counts as beg corner space)*, drop B to back of work, pick up A, ch 1; turn – 60 ch-spaces.

Rnd 7 (WS) With A and larger hook, sc in each ch-space; turn. Keeping strands to back of work, slip st backwards into beg sc of rnd; drop A – 60 sc.

Rnd 8 (RS) With B and smaller hook, ch 3, dc in same sc, ch 1, skip slip st, \*(2dcst, ch 1) in each sc to corner sc, (2dcst, ch 1) twice in corner sc. Repeat from \* 3 more times, ending last repeat 2dcst once in same sc as beg; join with sc in top of beg ch, drop B to back of work, pick up A, ch 1; turn – 64 ch-spaces.

Rnds 9-24 Repeat Rnds 7-8 for 8 more

times, increasing in pattern as established – 96 ch-spaces.

Rnd 25 (WS) With A and larger hook, sc in each ch-space; join with slip st in beg sc; turn – 96 sc.

Rnd 26 (RS) Ch 1, skip slip st, [sc in each sc to corner sc, 2 sc in corner sc] 4 times, ending last repeat 2 sc in last sc; join with slip st in beg sc.
Fasten off. Weave in ends. To open up the stitch pattern and achieve finished length of 19" [48.5 cm], thoroughly dampen Poncho and spread on clean towel(s) on a carpeted floor or on a bed. Gently ease Poncho into shape, blocking to size, pinning where necessary. Allow

to dry completely.
