# **SKILL LEVEL: Easy**

#### SIZE

16" x 64" [40.5 x 162.5 cm]

#### **MATERIALS**

• LION BRAND Lion Suede

1 ball #140 Rose (A)

1 ball #146 Fuchsia (B)

1 ball #132 Olive (C)

1 ball #126 Coffee (D)

1 ball #125 Mocha (E)

1 ball #147 Eggplant (F)

1 ball #178 Teal (G)

1 ball #133 Spice (H)

1 ball #110 Denim (I)

or colors of your choice

- LION BRAND size I-9 [5.5 mm] crochet hook OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE
- LION BRAND large-eyed, blunt needle

#### **GAUGE**

12 sc + 11 rows = 4" [10 cm].

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

TRIANGLE – Make 24

**Note** Make 3 each with A, B, C, D, E, and F; 2 each with G, H, and I. Ch 4.

**Row 1** (right side) Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across; turn -3 sc.

**Row 2** Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in next sc, 2 sc in last sc; turn -5 sc.

**Row 3** Ch 1, sc in each sc across; turn -5 sc.

**Row 4** Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in each sc across to last sc, 2 sc in last sc; turn – 7 sc.

**Rows 5-20** Repeat Rows 3-4-23 sc at end of Row 20.

Rows 21-22 Repeat Row 3.

Fasten off, leaving a tail for sewing.

# **FINISHING**

With large-eyed, blunt needle and tails, sew Triangles together following Construction Diagram.


#### **FRINGE**

Cut 20 strands, each 18" [45.5 cm] long, of each of A, B, C, D, E, and F. For each fringe along one end of Shawl, use 2 strands each of A, B, and C (6 strands total for each fringe). For each fringe along other end of Shawl, use 2 strands each of D, E, and F. To attach each fringe, fold strands in half and, with crochet hook, pull fold through Shawl, forming a loop. Pull ends of fringe through this loop. Pull to tighten. Attach fringes evenly across each end of Shawl.

ch = chain	sc = single crochet	

\*Lion Suede (Article #210) A luxuriously soft yarn with a suede finish. Bulky Weight; 100% Polyester Solids are packaged in 3 oz/85g (122 yd/110 m) skeins, prints are packaged in 2 3/4 oz [78 g]/111 yd [101 m] balls

# **Crochet Geometry Beret**

Pattern: 50047

SKILL: EASY +

#### SIZE

Circumference 21" [53.5 cm] at lower edge of band

### **MATERIALS**

• LION BRAND Lion Suede

1 ball #125 Mocha (A)

1 ball #178 Teal (B)

1 ball #146 Fuchsia (C)

1 ball #126 Coffee (D)

1 ball #133 Spice (E)

1 ball #147 Eggplant (F)

1 ball #140 Rose (G)

1 ball #132 Olive (H)

or colors of your choice

- LION BRAND size H-8 [5 mm] crochet hook OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE
- LION BRAND size G-6 [4 mm] crochet hook
- LION BRAND size F-5 [3.75 mm] crochet hook
- LION BRAND large-eyed, blunt needle

### **GAUGE**

12 sc + 9 rows = 4" [10 cm] on largest hook. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

### STITCH EXPLANATION

**sc2tog** (**sc decrease**) Insert hook into st and draw up a loop. Insert hook into next st and draw up a loop. Yarn over, draw through all 3 loops on hook.

**FPdc** (**front post dc**) Yo, working from front to back to front, insert hook around post of st of row below, yo and draw up a loop, (yo and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice. Skip st behind the FPdc.

#### **NOTE**

Center of Beret is made of 8 Triangles worked off a center ring, then sewn together with tail from previous Triangle.

#### FIRST TRIANGLE

With largest hook and D, ch 4; join with slip st to form ring.

**Row 1 (RS)** Ch 1, sc in ring; turn -1 sc.

Row 2 Ch 1, 2 sc in sc; turn -2 sc.

**Row 3** Ch 1, 2 sc in each sc across; turn -4 sc.

Row 4 Ch 1, sc in each sc across; turn.

**Row 5** Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in each sc across to last st, 2 sc in last sc; turn – 6 sc.

Rows 6-7 Repeat Row 4.

**Row 8** Repeat Row 5 - 8 sc.

Rows 9-10 Repeat Row 4.

**Row 11** Ch 1, sc in each of first 3 sc, 2 sc in each of next 2 sc, sc in each of last 3 sc; turn – 10 sc.

Row 12 Repeat Row 4.

Fasten off, leaving a 10" [25.5 cm] tail for sewing.

### **SECOND TRIANGLE**

With RS of First Triangle facing and largest hook, join B in center ring, to the right of previous Triangle. Repeat Rows 1-12 of First Triangle. Using tail from previous Triangle, matching sts, sew First and Second Triangles tog across side edge.

### THIRD THROUGH EIGHTH TRIANGLES

Make and join 6 more Triangles as for Second Triangle, in the following color sequence:

3rd Triangle with C

4th Triangle with E

5th Triangle with F

6th Triangle with A

7th Triangle with G

8th Triangle with H

With tail from last Triangle, sew last Triangle to First Triangle. Weave in ends.

#### SIDES AND BAND

**Rnd 1** With RS facing and largest hook, join A in first sc of any Triangle, ch 1, sc in each sc around; join with slip st in first sc -80 sc.

**Rnd 2** Ch 1, sc in each sc around; join with slip st in first sc.

**Rnd 3** Ch 1, \*sc in each of next 8 sc, sc2tog in next 2 sts; repeat from \* around; join with slip st in first sc - 72 sc.

Rnd 4 Repeat Rnd 2.

**Rnd 5** Ch 1, \*sc in each of next 7 sc, sc2tog in next 2 sts; repeat from \* around; join with slip st in first sc -64 sc.

**Rnd 6** Repeat Rnd 2.

Rnd 7 Ch 1, \*sc in sc, ch 1, skip next sc; repeat from \* around; join with slip st in first sc – 32 ch1-spaces. Fasten off.

**Rnd 8** With RS facing, join B in first sc, ch 1, \*sc in sc, ch 1, skip next ch1-space; repeat from \* around; join with slip st in first sc.

**Rnd 9** Ch 1, \*sc in sc, ch 1, skip next ch1-space; repeat from \* around; join with slip st in first sc.

Rnd 10 Ch 1, \*sc in sc, ch 1, skip next ch1-space, FPdc around the post of next corresponding sc 2 rnds below, ch 1, skip next ch1-space; repeat from \* around; join with slip st in first sc.

**Rnd 11** Ch 1, \*sc in sc, ch 1, skip next ch1-space, sc in next FPdc, ch 1, skip next ch1-space; repeat from \* around; join with slip st in first sc. Fasten off.

**Rnd 12** With smallest hook, join C in any sc, \*ch 2, skip next ch1-space, slip st in next sc; repeat from \* around -32 ch2-spaces.

Fasten off. Weave in ends.

## **FLOWER** (optional)

With middle-sized hook and C, leaving a tail for sewing, ch 4; join with slip st to form ring.

**Rnd 1** Ch 1, [sc, ch 3] 6 times in ring; join with slip st in first sc – 6 ch3-loops.

Rnd 2 Ch 1, working behind loops of Rnd 1, \*sc in center ring between next 2 sc of Rnd 1, ch 3; repeat from \* around; join with slip st in first sc - 6 ch3-loops.

**Rnd 3** Ch 1, \*sc in sc, 5 dc in next ch3-loop of Rnd 2; repeat from \* around; join with slip st in first sc - 6 petals.

Fasten off.

With large-eyed, blunt needle and tail, sew Flower to center top of Beret.
