


SIZE

Finished Circumference About 22 in. (56 cm) Finished Height About 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ in. (14 cm)



GAUGE

11 single crochets + 12 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

NOTES


- 1. Two rectangles are worked separately then sewn together to make Cowl.
- 2. To change color, work last stitch of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops to complete stitch.

STEP 1

Rectangle 1 With A, chain 17.

STEP 2

Row 1: Single crochet in second chain from hook and in each chain across – 16 single crochets.



STEP 3


Row 2: Chain 1, turn, single crochet in each stitch to end of row.

Rows 3-16: Repeat Row 2, changing to B in the last stitch of Row 16.



STEP 4

Rows 17-32: With B, repeat Row 2.
Fasten off.



STEP 5

Rectangle 2

With A, chain 31.

Row 1: Single crochet in second chain from hook and in each chain across – 30 single crochets.

Row 2: Chain 1, turn, single crochet in each stitch across.

Rows 3-8: Repeat Row 2, changing to B in the last stitch of Row 8.


Rows 9-16: With B, repeat Row 2.

Fasten off.



STEP 6

Sew ends of Rectangles together to make one long strip. Sew ends of strip together to make Cowl.



FINISHING

Weave in ends.
