MATERIALS

- LION BRAND[®] LION'S PRIDE[®] WOOLSPUN[®] (Art. #671)
 - #180 Cranberry 1 ball (A)
 - #130 Honey 1 ball (B)
 - #140 Violet 1 ball (C)
 - #102 Aquamarine 1 ball (D)
 - #173 Avocado 2 balls (E)
 - #133 Rust 2 balls (F)
 - #109 Royal Blue 3 balls (G)
 - #170 Peacock 4 balls (H)
 - #174 Evergreen 4 balls (I)
 - #189 Claret 1 ball (J)or colors of your choice
- LION BRAND[®] crochet hook size K-10.5 (6.5mm)
- LION BRAND[®] large-eyed blunt needle



SIZE

About 42 x 42 in. (106.5 x 106.5 cm),
including border

GAUGE

11 sc + 12 rows = 4 in. (10 cm).
1 Block = About 10 x 10 in. (25.5 x 25.5 cm)

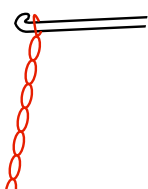
BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

NOTES

1. 16 identical Blocks are made, then sewn together to make Afghan.
2. An edging is worked around the outside edge of the Afghan.
3. To change color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st. Proceed with new color. Fasten off old color.

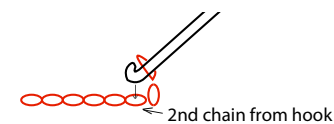
STEP 1

BLOCK (make 16)
With A, ch 7.



STEP 2

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across - 6 sc.

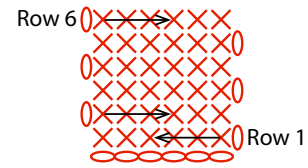


XXXXXX Row 1
6 single crochet

○ chain
X single crochet

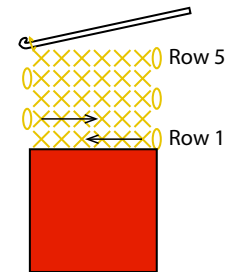
STEP 3

Rows 2-6: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across; change to B in last st of Row 6.



STEP 4

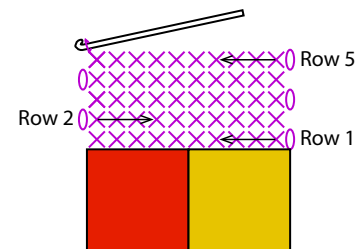
Rows 1-5: With B, ch 1, turn, sc in each st across; change to C in last st of Row 5.



STEP 5

Row 1: With C, ch 1, do not turn, work 10 sc evenly spaced across side edge of Step 4 and edge of Step 3.

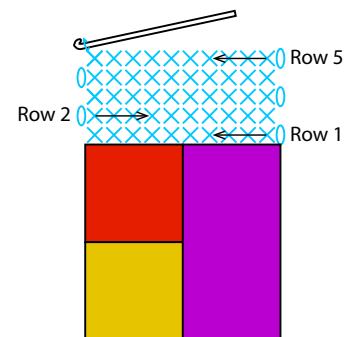
Rows 2-5: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across; change to D in last st of Row 5.



STEP 6

Row 1: With D, ch 1, do not turn, work 10 sc evenly spaced across side edge of Step 5 and next edge of Step 3.

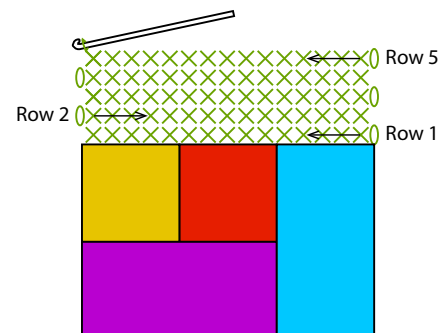
Rows 2-5: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across; change to E in last st of Row 5.



STEP 7

Row 1: With E, ch 1, do not turn, work 15 sc evenly spaced across side edge of Step 6, next edge of Step 3 and side edge of Step 4.

Rows 2-5: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across; change to F in last st of Row 5.



STEP 8

Row 1: With F, ch 1, do not turn, work 15 sc evenly spaced across side edge of Step 7, last row of Step 4 and side edge of Step 5.

Rows 2-7: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across; change to G in last st of Row 7.

STEP 9

Row 1: With G, ch 1, do not turn, work 21 sc evenly spaced across side edge of Step 8, last row of Step 5 and side edge of Step 6.

Rows 2-7: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across; change to H in last st of Row 7.

STEP 10

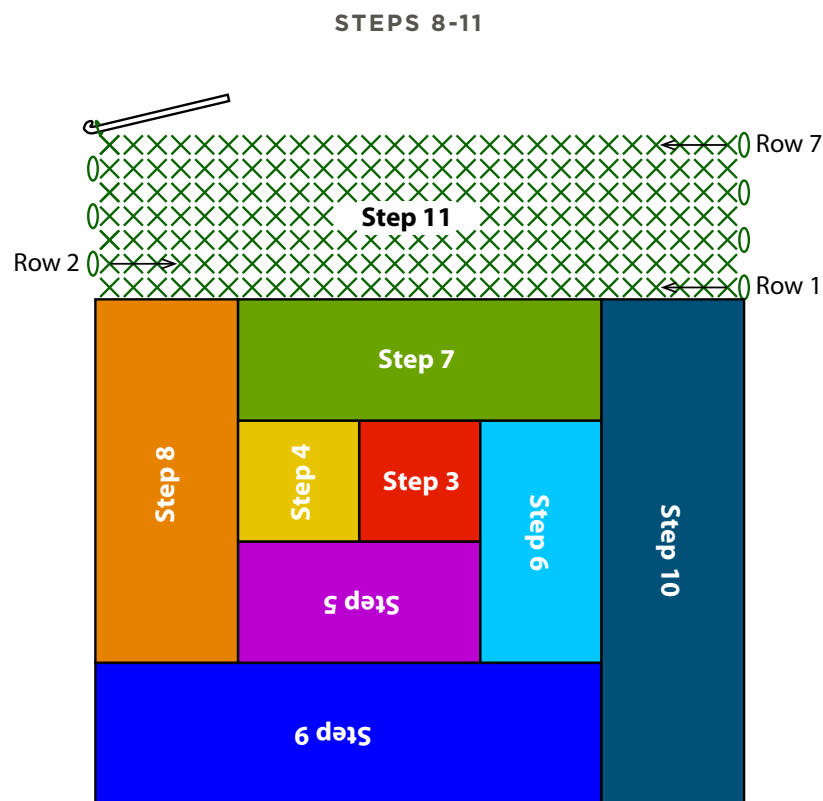
Row 1: With H, ch 1, do not turn, work 21 sc evenly spaced across side edge of Step 9, last row of Step 6 and side edge of Step 7.

Rows 2-7: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across; change to I in last st of Row 7.

STEP 11

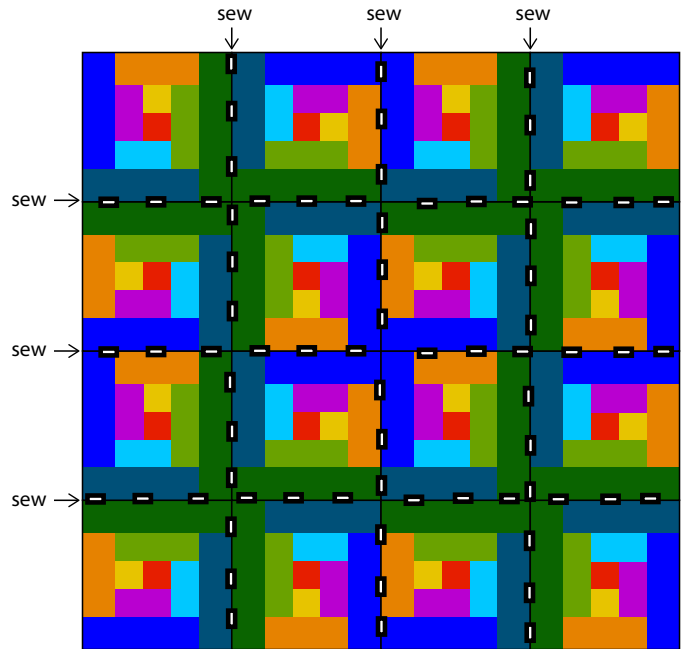
Row 1: With I, ch 1, do not turn, work 27 sc evenly spaced across side edge of Step 10, last row of Step 7 and side edge of Step 8.

Rows 2-7: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across. Fasten off.



STEP 12

Sew Blocks into 4 strips of 4 Blocks each. Sew strips together to make Afghan.

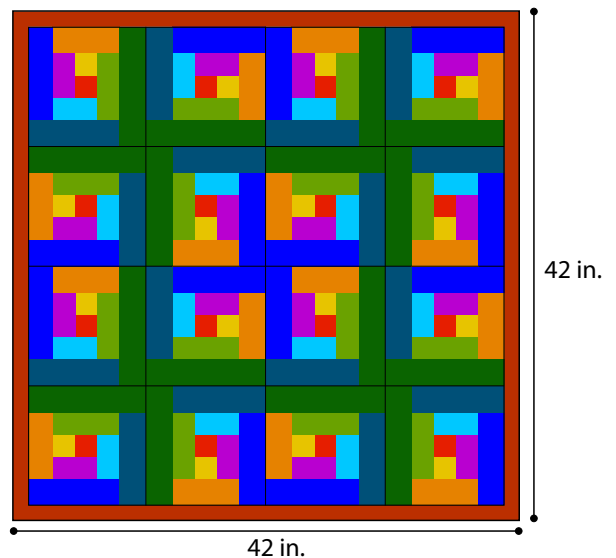
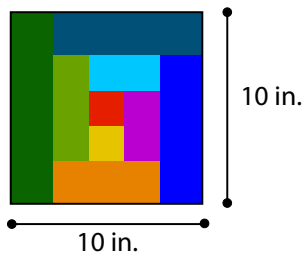


STEP 13

Edging

Rnd 1: From RS, join J with sl st in any st along outer edge of Afghan. Ch 1, work sc evenly spaced around entire outside edge, working 3 sc in each corner; join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, do not turn, sc in each st around, working 3 sc in center sc of each corner; join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off.



FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain
rnd = round

sc = single crochet
sl st = slip stitch

st(s) = stitch(es)
