

## SIZE

About 24 x 56 in. (61 x 142 cm), before folding and seaming.

## GAUGE

10 sts + 7 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) over Rows 2 and 3.


BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

### **NOTES**


- 1. Poncho is worked in one piece, changing yarn color to create stripes.
- 2. To change color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete the st. Fasten off old color and proceed with new color.


Row 1 (RS): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across - 60 sc.



### STEP 3


**Row 2:** Ch 1, turn, working in front loops only, sl st in each st across.

**Row 3:** Ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, working in back loops only, dc in next st and in each st across, changing to B in last st.



## STEP 4

Rows 4-11: With B, rep Rows 2 and 3 four times, changing to C in last st of Row 11.



#### STEP 5

Rows 12-15: With C, rep Rows 2 and 3 twice,

changing to B in last st of Row 15.

Rows 16-19: With B, rep Rows 2 and 3 twice,

changing to A in last st of Row 19.

Rows 20-45: With A, rep Rows 2 and 3 thirteen

times, changing to B in last st of Row 45.

Rows 46-49: With B, rep Rows 2 and 3 twice,

changing to C in last st of Row 49.

Rows 50-53: With C, rep Rows 2 and 3 twice,

changing to B in last st of Row 53.

Rows 54-61: With B, rep Rows 2 and 3 four times,

changing to C in last st of Row 61.

Rows 62-65: With C, rep Rows 2 and 3 twice,

changing to B in last st of Row 65.

Rows 66-73: With B, rep Rows 2 and 3 four times,

changing to A in last st of Row 73.

Rows 74-97: With A, rep Rows 2 and 3 twelve times.

Row 98: With A, ch 1, turn, working in back loops


only, sc in each st across.

Fasten off.



# STEP 6

Fold piece in half with wrong sides together. Beginning at one corner, sew one long edge together for 16 in. (40.5 cm), leaving 12 in. (30.5 cm) open for neck.




## STEP 7

### **Neck Edging**

From RS, join A with a sl st anywhere along neck edge, ch 1, work sc evenly spaced around neck; join with sl st in first sc.

Fasten off.



## **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.

## **ABBREVIATIONS**

**ch** = chain

**dc** = double crochet

RS = right side

rep = repeat

sc = single crochet

sl st = slip stitch

st(s) = stitch(es)
