LEVEL 1-BEGINNER KNIT PULLOVER

LION BRAND[®] LION'S PRIDE[®] WOOLSPUN[®]



MATERIALS

- LION BRAND[®] LION'S PRIDE[®] WOOLSPUN[®] (Art. #671)
 - #170 Peacock 6 (7, 7) balls (A)
 - #153 Black 2 (2, 2) balls (B)
 - or colors of your choice
- LION BRAND[®] stitch markers
- LION BRAND[®] large-eyed blunt needle

ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

- Circular knitting needle size 10.5 (6.5 mm), 29 in. (73.5 cm) long

SIZE

S (M, L)

Finished Width About 30 (32, 34) in. (76 (81.5, 86.5) cm)

Finished Length About 25 ½ (27, 28 ½) in. (65 (68.5, 72.5) cm)

Note: Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

GAUGE

12 sts + 16 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in St st (k on RS, p on WS).

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

NOTES

1. Pullover is made in 2 pieces: Back and Front. The Cowl and Belt are made separately.
2. Back and Front are worked horizontally from side to side on a circular needle. Work back and forth on circular needle as if working on straight needles.
3. Cowl is worked in the round.

STEP 1

PULLOVER

BACK

With longer circular needle and A, cast on 77 (81, 85) sts. Work back and forth in rows on circular needle as if working on straight needles.

Row 1 (RS): K1, *p1, k1; rep from * to end of row.

Rep last row 8 more times for Seed st side border.

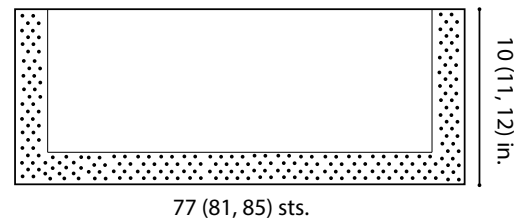


STEP 2

Row 1 (WS): K1, (p1, k1) 3 times for Seed st lower border, p to last 7 sts for St st (k on RS, p on WS) center section, k1, (p1, k1) 3 times for Seed st top border.

Row 2 (RS): K1, (p1, k1) 3 times, k to last 7 sts, k1, (p1, k1) 3 times.

Rep last 2 rows until piece measures about 10 (11, 12) in. (25.5 (28, 30.5) cm) from beg, end with a WS row as the last row you work. **Note:** End with a WS row means that the last row you work should be a WS row, and the next row that you are ready to work will be a RS row.



STEP 3

Make First Slit for Belt

Row 1 (RS): K1, (p1, k1) 3 times, k48, bind off next 6 sts for belt hole, k to last 7 sts, k1, (p1, k1) 3 times.

Row 2: K1, (p1, k1) 3 times, p to bound-off sts, cast on 6 sts over the bound-off sts, p to last 7 sts, k1, (p1, k1) 3 times.

Row 3: K1, (p1, k1) 3 times, k to last 7 sts, k1, (p1, k1) 3 times.

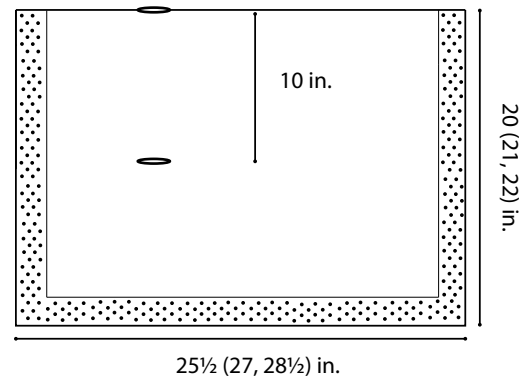
Row 4: K1, (p1, k1) 3 times, p to last 7 sts, k1, (p1, k1) 3 times.

Rep last 2 rows until piece measures about 20 (21, 22) in. (25.5 (53.5, 56) cm) from beg, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Make Second Slit for Belt

Next Row (RS): K1, (p1, k1) 3 times, k48, bind off next 6 sts for belt hole, k to last 7 sts, k1, (p1, k1) 3 times.

Next Row: K1, (p1, k1) 3 times, p to bound-off sts, cast on 6 sts over bound-off sts, p to last 7 sts, k1, (p1, k1) 3 times.



STEP 4

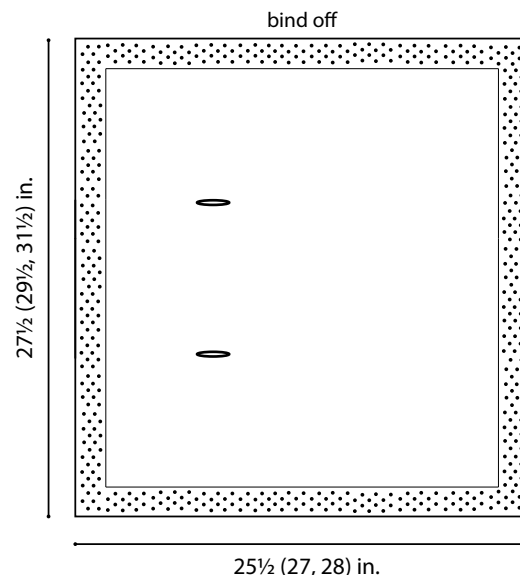
Row 1 (RS): K1, (p1, k1) 3 times, k to last 7 sts, k1, (p1, k1) 3 times.

Row 2: K1, (p1, k1) 3 times, p to last 7 sts, k1, (p1, k1) 3 times.

Rep last 2 rows until piece measures about 27 1/2 (29 1/2, 31 1/2) in. (70 (75, 80) cm) from beg, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Next Row: K1, *p1, k1; rep from * to end of row.

Rep last row 8 more times for Seed st side border. Bind off.



STEP 5

FRONT

Follow Steps 1-4 to make the Front same as the Back.

STEP 6

BELT

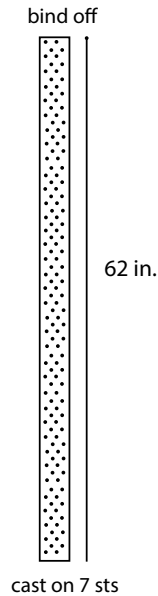
With shorter circular needle and B, cast on 7 sts. Work back and forth in rows as if working with straight needles.

Row 1: K1, (p1, k1) 3 times.

Rep Row 1 until piece measures about 62 in.

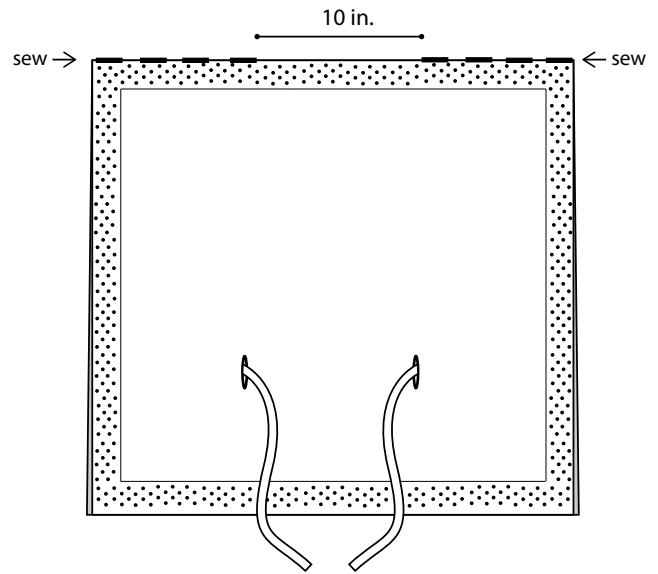
(152.5 cm) from beg.

Bind off.



STEP 7

Sew shoulders, leaving center 10 in. (25.5 cm) unsewn for neck opening.



STEP 8

COWL

With shorter circular needle and B, cast on 84 sts. Place marker for beg of rnd. Join by working the first st on left hand needle with the working yarn from the right hand needle and being careful not to twist sts.

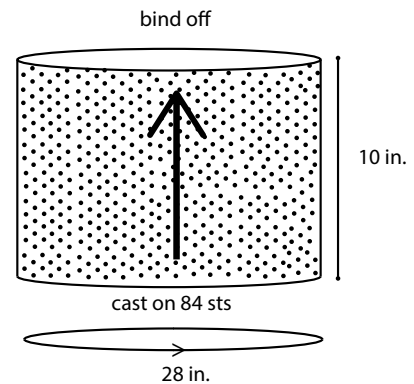
Rnd 1: *K1, p1; rep from * around.

Rnd 2: *P1, k1; rep from * around.

Rep Rnds 1 and 2 until piece measures about 10 in.

(25.5 cm) from beg.

Bind off.



FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Thread Belt through slits.

ABBREVIATIONS

beg = begin(ning)(s)

k = knit

k2tog = knit 2 stitches together

p = purl

rep = repeat(s)(ing)

rnd(s) = round(s)

RS = right side

St st = Stockinette stitch

st(s) = stitch(es)

WS = wrong side
