3 Balls (D)

• <u>Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size I-</u>

GAUGE:


One Patch = about 2 $1/2 \times 3 1/4$ in. (6.5 x 8.5 cm) One Block = about 7 $1/2 \times 9 1/2$ in. (19 x 24 cm)

When you match the <u>qauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

- 1. Mat is made from 9 Blocks.
- 2. Each Block is made from 9 patches. The color of the patches in each Block are alternated to create a checkerboard pattern.
- 3. All patches have the same number of rows and sts.
- 4. Patches and Blocks are worked using a "join as you go" technique. Refer to layout diagram for arrangement of Patches and Blocks.
- 5. Border is worked around the outer edge of the Mat.



BLOCK 1

Patch 1

With C, ch 10.

Row 1 (RS): Sc in 2nd ch from hook, (ch 1, sk next ch, sc in next ch) 4 times – 5 sc and 4 ch-1 sps.

Rows 2-11: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) 4 times.

Fasten off.

Patch 2 From RS, draw up a loop of D in 9th ch of Patch 1, ch 11.

Note: The 9th ch of Patch 1 is the ch at the base of the first sc of Row 1.

Row 1 (RS): Sc in 2nd ch from hook, (ch 1, sk next ch, sc in next ch) 4 times, sk last ch, sl st in end of Row 1 of Patch 1 – 5 sc and 4 ch-1 sps.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) 4 times.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) 4 times, sl st in end of corresponding row of Patch 1.

Rows 4-11: Rep Rows 2 and 3 four more times.

Do not fasten off.

Patch 3

Row 1 (RS): Ch 1, do not turn, working across top of Patch 1, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) 4 times – 5 sc and 4 ch-1 sps.

Rows 2-11: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) 4 times.

Fasten off.

Patch 4

From RS, draw up a loop of C in 10th ch of Patch 2, ch 11.

Note: The 10th ch of Patch 2 is the ch at the base of the first sc of Row 1 of the Patch.

Row 1 (RS): Sc in 2nd ch from hook, (ch 1, sk next ch, sc in next ch) 4 times, sk last ch, sl st in end of Row 1 of Patch 2 – 5 sc and 4 ch-1 sps.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) 4 times.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) 4 times, sl st in end of corresponding row of Patch 2.

Rows 4-11: Rep Rows 2 and 3 four more times.

Do not fasten off.

Patch 5

Row 1 (RS): Ch 1, do not turn, working across top of Patch 2, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) 4 times, sl st in end of Row 1 of Patch 3 – 5 sc and 4 ch-1 sps.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) 4 times.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) 4 times, sl st in end of corresponding row of Patch

3.

Rows 4-11: Rep Rows 2 and 3 four more times.

Do not fasten off.

Patch 6

Row 1 (RS): Ch 1, do not turn, working across top of Patch 3, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) 4 times – 5 sc and 4 ch-1 sps.

Rows 2-11: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) 4 times.

Fasten off.

Patch 7

Row 1 (RS): From RS, join D with sc in first sc of last row of Patch 4, (ch 1, sk next ch, sc in next ch) 4 times, sl st in end of Row 1 of Patch 5 – 5 sc and 4 ch-1 sps.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) 4 times.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) 4 times, sl st in end of corresponding row of Patch 5.

Rows 4-11: Rep Rows 2 and 3 four more times.

Do not fasten off.

Patch 8

Row 1 (RS): Ch 1, do not turn, working across top of Patch 5, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) 4 times, sl st in end of Row 1 of Patch 6 – 5 sc and 4 ch-1 sps.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) 4 times.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) 4 times, sl st in end of corresponding row of Patch 6.

Rows 4-11: Rep Rows 2 and 3 four more times.

Fasten off.

Patch 9

Row 1 (RS): From RS, join C with sc in first sc of last row of Patch 7, (ch 1, sk next ch, sc in next ch) 4 times, sl st in end of Row 1 of Patch 8 – 5 sc and 4 ch-1 sps.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) 4 times.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) 4 times, sl st in end of corresponding row of Patch 8.

Rows 4-11: Rep Rows 2 and 3 four more times.

Fasten off.

BLOCK 2

Patch 1

Row 1 (RS): From RS, join B with sc in first sc of last row of Patch 6 of Block 1, continuing across top of Patch 6 of Block 1, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) 4 times – 5 sc and 4 ch-1 sps.

Rows 2-11: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) 4 times.

Fasten off.

Patch 2

Row 1 (RS): From RS, join D with sc in first sc of last row of Patch 8 of Block 1, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) 4 times, sl st in end of Row 1 of Patch 1 of this Block – 5 sc and 4 ch-1 sps.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) 4 times.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) 4 times, sl st in end of corresponding row of Patch 1.

Rows 4-11: Rep Rows 2 and 3 four more times.

Do not fasten off.

Patch 3

With D, work same as Patch 3 of Block 1, beg across top of Patch 1 of this Block.

Fasten off.

Patch 4

Row 1 (RS): From RS, join B with sc in first sc of last row of Patch 9 of Block 1, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) 4 times, sl st in end of Row 1 of Patch 2 of this Block – 5 sc and 4 ch-1 sps.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) 4 times.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) 4 times, sl st in end of corresponding row of Patch 2.

Rows 4-11: Rep Rows 2 and 3 four more times.

Do not fasten off.

Patches 5 and 6 With B, work same as Patches 5 and 6 of Block 1.

Fasten off.

Patches 7 and 8

With D, work same as Patches 7 and 8 of Block 1.

Fasten off.

Patch 9

With B, work same as Patch 9 of Block 1.

Fasten off.

BLOCK 3

Patch 1

Row 1 (RS): From RS, join C with sc in first sc of last row of Patch 6 of Block 2, continuing across top of Patch 6 of Block 2, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) 4 times.

Rows 2-11: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) 4 times.

Fasten off.

Patch 2

Row 1 (RS): From RS, join D with sc in first sc of last row of Patch 8 of Block 2, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) 4 times, sl st in end of Row 1 of Patch 1 of this Block.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) 4 times.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) 4 times, sl st in end of corresponding row of Patch 1.

Rows 4-11: Rep Rows 2 and 3 four more times.

Do not fasten off.

Patch 3

With D, work same as Patch 3 of Block 1.

Fasten off.

Patch 4

Row 1 (RS): From RS, join C with sc in first sc of last row of Patch 9 of Block 2, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) 4 times, sl st in end of Row 1 of Patch 2 of this Block.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) 4 times.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) 4 times, sl st in end of corresponding row of Patch 2.

Rows 4-11: Rep Rows 2 and 3 four more times.

Do not fasten off.

Patches 5-9

Using same colors as in Block 1, work same as Patches 5-9 of Block 1.

Fasten off.

BLOCK 4

From RS, draw up a loop of B in 10th ch of Patch 4 of Block 1.

Row 1 (RS): Sc in 2nd ch from hook, (ch 1, sk next ch, sc in next ch) 4 times, sk last ch, sl st in end of Row 1 of Patch 4 of Block 1 – 5 sc and 4 ch-1 sps.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) 4 times.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) 4 times, sl st in end of corresponding row of Patch 4 of Block 1.

Rows 4-11: Rep Rows 2 and 3 four more times.

Fasten off.

Patch 2

With D, work same as Patch 2 of Block 1.

Patch 3

Row 1 (RS): Ch 1, do not turn, working across top of Patch 1 of this Block, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) 4 times, sl st in end of Row 1 of Patch 7 of Block 1 – 5 sc and 4 ch-1 sps.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) 4 times.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) 4 times, sl st in end of corresponding row of Patch 7 of Block 1.

Rows 4-11: Rep Rows 2 and 3 four more times.

Fasten off.

Patches 4 and 5

With B, work same as Patches 4 and 5 of Block 1.

Do not fasten off.

Patch 6

Row 1 (RS): Ch 1, do not turn, working across top of Patch 3 of this Block, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) 4 times, sl st in end of Row 1 of Patch 9 of Block 1 – 5 sc and 4 ch-1 sps.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) 4 times.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) 4 times, sl st in end of corresponding row of Patch 9 of Block 1.

Rows 4-11: Rep Rows 2 and 3 four more times.

Fasten off.

Patches 7-9

Using same colors as in Block 2, work same as Patches 7-9 of Block 2.

Fasten off.

BLOCK 5

Patch 1

Row 1 (RS): From RS, join C with sc in first sc of last row of Patch 6 of Block 4, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) 4 times, sl st in end of Row 1 of Patch 4 of Block 2.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) 4 times.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) 4 times, sl st in end of corresponding row of Patch 4 of Block 2.

Rows 4-11: Rep Rows 2 and 3 four more times.

Fasten off.

Patch 2

With D, work same as Patch 2 of Block 3, beg across top of Patch 8 of Block 4.

Do not fasten off.

Patch 3

Row 1 (RS): Ch 1, do not turn, working across top of Patch 1 of this Block, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) 4 times, sl st in end of Row 1 of Patch 7 of Block 2.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) 4 times.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) 4 times, sl st in end of corresponding row of Patch 7 of Block 2.

Rows 4-11: Rep Rows 2 and 3 four more times.

Fasten off.

Patches 4 and 5

With C, work same as Patches 4 and 5 of Block 3, beg across top of Patch 9 of Block 4.

Do not fasten off

Patch 6

Row 1 (RS): Ch 1, do not turn, working across top of Patch 3 of this Block, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) 4 times, sl st in end of Row 1 of Patch 9 of Block 2.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) 4 times.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) 4 times, sl st in end of corresponding row of Patch 9 of Block 2.

Rows 4-11: Rep Rows 2 and 3 four more times.

Fasten off.

Patches 7-9

Using same colors as in Block 3, work same as Patches 7-9 of Block 3.

Fasten off.

BLOCK 6

Work same as Block 5, using B instead of C, beg across top of Block 5, and attaching to side of Block 3.

BLOCK 7

Work same as Block 4, using C instead of B, and attaching to side of Block 4.

BLOCK 8

Work same as Block 6, using same colors as in Block 6, beg across top of Block 7, and attaching to side of Block 5.

BLOCK 9

Work same as Block 5, using same colors as in Block 5, beg across top of Block 8, and attaching to side of Block 6.

FINISHING

Border

Rnd 1 (RS): From RS, join A with sc in end of Row 1 of Patch 7 of Block 7 (this is the first D-colored row on a long edge), work 9 more sc evenly spaced across edge of Patch, work 10 sc evenly spaced across edge of each of next 7 Patches, (sc, ch 2, sc) in corner; working across short edge, work 8 sc evenly spaced across edge of first Patch, work 9 sc evenly spaced across edge of last Patch, (sc, ch 2, sc) in corner; working across long edge, work 9 sc evenly spaced across edge of first Patch, work 10 sc evenly spaced across edge of each of next 8 Patches, (sc, ch 2, sc) in corner; working across short edge, work 8 sc evenly spaced across edge of first Patch, work 9 sc evenly spaced across edge of each of next 7 Patches, work 8 sc evenly spaced across edge of last Patch, (sc, ch 2, sc) in corner; work 9 sc evenly spaced across edge of first Patch of first long edge; join with sl st in first sc – 344 sc (81 sc across each short edge and 91 sc across each long edge) and 4 corner ch-2 sps.

Rnd 2 (WS): Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc around, working (sc, ch 2, sc) in each corner ch-2 sp; join with sl st in first sc – 352 sc (83 sc across each short edge and 93 sc across each long edge) and 4 corner ch-2 sps.

Rnd 3 (RS): Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (*ch 1, sk next sc, sc in next sc; rep from * to sc before next corner ch-2 sp, ch 1, sk next sc, (sc, ch 2, sc) in corner ch-2 sp) 4 times, **ch 1, sk next sc, sc in next sc; rep from ** to last sc, ch 1, sk last sc; join with sl st in first sc.

Fasten off.

Weave in ends.
