# LEVEL 3-EASY+ KNIT AFGHAN

LION BRAND<sup>®</sup> LION'S PRIDE<sup>®</sup> WOOLSPUN<sup>®</sup>



## MATERIALS

- LION BRAND<sup>®</sup> LION'S PRIDE<sup>®</sup> WOOLSPUN<sup>®</sup> (Art. #671)
  - #110 Navy Heather 2 balls (A)
  - #147 Purple 2 balls (B)
  - #140 Violet 2 balls (C)
  - #109 Royal Blue 2 balls (D)
  - #129 Mahogany 2 balls (E)
  - #123 Taupe 2 balls (F)
  - #030 Honey 2 balls (G)
  - #173 Avocado 2 balls (H)
  - #102 Aquamarine 2 balls (I)
  - #170 Peacock 2 balls (J)
  - #174 Evergreen 1 ball (K)
  - or colors of your choice
- LION BRAND<sup>®</sup> large-eyed blunt needle

## ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

- Circular knitting needle size 10.5 (6.5 mm), 29 in. (73.5 cm) long

## SIZE

About 40 x 49 in. (101.5 x 124.5 cm)

## GAUGE

14 sts + 24 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Slip St pattern.

**BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.**

## NOTES

1. Afghan is worked in one piece in a Slip St pattern.
2. Slip all slip sts as if to purl. When slipping sts on RS rows, hold the working yarn in back of the piece (wyib). When slipping sts on WS rows, hold the working yarn in front of the piece (wyif). This keeps the strands of yarn on the WS of the piece.
3. The Slip St pattern is worked with 2 colors. Carry color not in use along the side edge of the piece until the instructions say to cut it.
4. The color combination is changed every 30 rows by cutting one of the colors from the previous 30-row section and continuing with a new color.
5. A circular needle is used to accommodate the large number of sts. Work back and forth on circular needle as if working on straight needles.

## STEP 1

With A, cast on 140 sts.

### Begin Slip St Pattern

**Rows 1 and 2:** With A, knit.

**Row 3 (RS):** With B, k1, \*k2, sl 1 wyib;  
rep from \* to last st, k1.

**Rows 4:** With B, k1, \*sl 1 wyif, p2; rep from \* to last st, k1.

**Rows 5 and 6:** With A, knit.

**Rows 7-30:** Rep Rows 3-6.

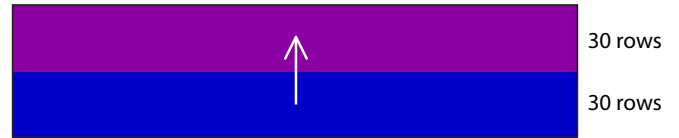
Cut A.



## STEP 2

With B instead of A and C instead of B,  
rep Rows 1-30 of Step 1.

Cut B.



## STEP 3

Rep Rows 1-30 of Step 2, using C instead of B and D instead of C.  
Cut C.

Rep Rows 1-30 of Step 2, using D instead of B and E instead of C.  
Cut D.

Rep Rows 1-30 of Step 2, using E instead of B and F instead of C.  
Cut E.

Rep Rows 1-30 of Step 2, using F instead of B and G instead of C.  
Cut F.

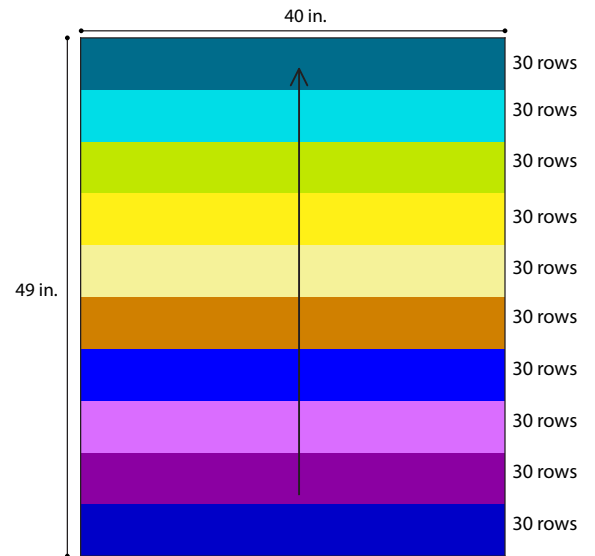
Rep Rows 1-30 of Step 2, using G instead of B and H instead of C.  
Cut G.

Rep Rows 1-30 of Step 2, using H instead of B and I instead of C.  
Cut H.

Rep Rows 1-30 of Step 2, using I instead of B and J instead of C.  
Cut I.

Rep Rows 1-30 of Step 2, using J instead of B and K instead of C.  
Cut J.

With K, bind off.



## FINISHING

Weave in ends.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**k** = knit

**p** = purl

**rep** = repeat

**RS** = right side

**sl** = slip

**st(s)** = stitch(es)

**WS** = wrong side

**wyib** = with yarn in back

**wyif** = with yarn in front
