MATERIALS

- 492-207 [Lion Brand LB Collection Silk Yarn: Leo](#)
1 Ball (A)
- 492-203 [Lion Brand LB Collection Silk Yarn: Phoenix](#)
1 Ball (B)
- [Lion Brand Knitting Needles - Size 7 \[4.5 mm\]](#)
- [Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers](#)
- [Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles \(Set of 6\)](#)

**LB Collection Silk (Article #492). 100% Silk; package size: 1.75oz/50.00 gr. (163yds/150m) pull skeins*



GAUGE:

20 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) over Rows 1-5, after blocking.

When you match the [gauge](#) in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

ssk (slip, slip, knit) Slip next 2 sts as if to knit, one at a time, to right needle; insert left needle into fronts of these 2 sts and knit them tog – 1 st decreased.

NOTES:

1. Scarf is worked in one piece in alternating bands of St st (k on RS, p on WS) and rev St st (p on RS, k on WS).
2. We suggest that you wind the yarn into balls by hand, rather than using a ball winder.
3. Yarn color is changed every 2 rows. Carry unused color along side edge of work between color changes.
4. Beginning with Row 1, 4 sts are decreased on every knit row.

KERCHIEF

With A, loosely cast on 171 sts.

Purl one row, knit one row.

Change to B.

Purl one row, knit one row.

Next row (RS): With A, k85, place marker, k1, place marker, k to end of row.

Rev St st section (p on RS, k on WS)

Note: When working the remainder of the Kerchief, continue to change color every 2 rows.

Row 1 (WS Dec Row): K1, *ssk, k to 2 sts before marker, ssk, sl marker, k1, sl marker, k2tog, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1.

Row 2: Purl.

Rows 3 and 4: Rep Rows 1 and 2.

Row 5: Rep Row 1.

St st section (k on RS, p on WS)

Row 6 (RS Dec Row): K1, *ssk, k to 2 sts before marker, ssk, sl marker, k1, sl marker, k2tog, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1.

Row 7: Purl.

Rows 8-13: Rep Rows 6 and 7.

Row 14: Rep Row 6.

Continuing to change color every 2 rows, rep Rows 1-14 until 3 sts remain. Bind off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Soak Kerchief in warm water for about 20 minutes. Lift wet Kerchief carefully from water, then roll in a towel to remove excess water.

On a flat, pinnable surface, stretch damp Kerchief to finished measurements and pin in place. Allow to dry, then unpin.
