- 860-153 <u>Lion Brand Vanna's Choice</u> <u>Yarn: Black</u>
 - 1 Ball (A)
- 860-149 <u>Lion Brand Vanna's Choice</u> <u>Yarn: Silver Grey</u>
 - 1 Ball (B)
- 860-100 <u>Lion Brand Vanna's Choice</u> <u>Yarn: White</u>
 - 1 Ball (C)
- <u>Lion Brand Crochet Hook Size G-6</u>
 (4 mm)
- Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers
- <u>Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles</u> (Set of 6)
- Additional Materials
 Small amount of fiberfill stuffing

*<u>Vanna's Choice®</u> (Article #860). 100% Premium Acrylic

400, 401, 403: 92% Acrylic, 8% Rayon **402:** 96% Acrylic, 4% Rayon; package size: **Solids:** 3.5 oz (100 g), 170 yards (156 m) **Prints, Tweeds, & Heathers:** 3 ozs (85 g), 145 yards (133 meters)

Twists: 2.5 oz (70 g), 121 yards (111 meters)



GAUGE:

Exact gauge is not essential to this project.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

sc2tog (sc decrease) Insert hook into st and draw up a loop. Insert hook into next st and draw up a loop. Yarn over, draw through all 3 loops on hook.

French Knot

Thread needle and bring from back to front through knitted piece. Wrap yarn around needle 3 times, insert needle back into knitted piece close to where it emerged. Tighten knot.

NOTES:

- 1. Cauldron is worked in one piece in the rnd. Work in continuous rnds; do not join or turn unless otherwise instructed.
- 2. Handles, legs and spider are worked separately, then sewn to Cauldron.
- 3. Small details are embroidered onto Cauldron.

CAULDRON

With A, ch 2.

Rnd 1: Work 6 sc in first ch; place a marker for beg of rnd; move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in each sc around – 12 sts at the end of this rnd.

Rnd 3: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc; rep from * around - 18 sts.

Rnd 4: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc; rep from * around - 24 sts.

Rnd 5: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc; rep from * around - 30 sts.

Rnd 6: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc; rep from * around - 36 sts.
Rnd 7: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 5 sc; rep from * around - 42 sts.
Rnd 8: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 6 sc; rep from * around - 48 sts.
Rnd 9: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 7 sc; rep from * around – 54 sts.
Rnd 10: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 8 sc; rep from * around - 60 stts.
Rnd 11: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 9 sc; rep from * around – 66 sts.
Rnd 12: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 10 sc; rep from * around - 72 sts.
Rnd 13: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 11 sc; rep from * around - 78 sts.
Rnd 14: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 12 sc; rep from * around - 84 sts.
Rnd 15: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 13 sc; rep from * around - 90 sts.
Rnd 16: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 14 sc; rep from * around - 96 sts.
```

Rnds 17 and 18: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 19: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 15 sc; rep from * around - 102 sts.

Rnds 20 and 21: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 22: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 16 sc; rep from * around - 108 sts.

Rnds 23 and 24: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 25: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 17 sc; rep from * around - 114 sts.

Rnds 26 and 27: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 28: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 18 sc; rep from * around - 120 sts.

Rnds 29–35: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 36: *Sc2tog, sc in next 4 sc; rep from * around - 100 sts.

Rnd 37: *Sc2tog, sc in next 3 sc; rep from * around - 80 sts.

Rnds 38-43: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 44: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc; rep from * around - 100 sts.

Rnd 45: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc; rep from * around - 120 sts.

Rnd 46: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 47: *Sc2tog, sc in next 4 sc; rep from * around - 100 sts.

Rnd 48: *Sc2tog, sc in next 3 sc; rep from * around – 80 sts.

Fasten off.

LEGS (make 3)

With A, ch 2.

Rnd 1: Work 6 sc in first ch; place a marker for beg of rnd; move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in each sc around – 12 sc at the end of this rnd.

Rnd 3: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc; rep from * around - 18 sts.

Rnds 4-7: Sc in each sc around.

Fasten off.

HANDLES (make 2)

With A, ch 17.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – 16 sts.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in first 4 sc, *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc; rep from * 3 more times - 20 sts. Fasten off.

SPIDER

BODY

With B, ch 2.

Rnd 1: Work 6 sc in first ch; place a marker for beg of rnd; move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in each sc around - 12 sts at the end of this rnd.

Rnds 3-4: Sc in each sc around.

Fasten off.

HEAD

With B, ch 2.

Rnd 1: Work 6 sc in first ch; place a marker to indicate beg of rnd; move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: Sc in each sc around.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Stuff Legs firmly and sew to bottom of Cauldron, spaced evenly about 1 in. (2.5 cm) from beg chain. Notice that the top edge of the Cauldron rolls slightly. Sew a Handle to each side of Cauldron, just below the rolled top edge. With A, embroider French knot eyes on Spider head. Lightly stuff Spider head and body and sew to side of Cauldron. With C, embroider a straight st web near Spider. With B, embroider straight st Spider legs.
