SKILL LEVEL: Easy (Level 2)

SIZE: Child (Multiple Sizes), Small

Child XS (Child S, Child M, Child L/Adult S)

Finished Circumference About 15 (16, 17 1/2, 19 1/2) in. (38 (40.5, 44.5, 49.5) cm), will stretch to fit a range of sizes

Note: Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

MATERIALS

- 860-153 Lion Brand
Vanna's Choice Yarn: Black
1 Ball (A)
- 860-175 Lion Brand Vannas
Choice Yarn: Radiant Lime **Vanna's Choice® (Article #860). 100% Premium Acrylic*
1 Ball (B)
- 860-149 Lion Brand
Vanna's Choice Yarn: Silver **400, 401, 403:** 92% Acrylic, 8% Rayon
Grey **402:** 96% Acrylic, 4% Rayon; package
1 Ball (C) size: **Solids:** 3.5 oz (100 g), 170 yards (156 m)
- 860-100 Lion Brand **Prints, Tweeds, & Heathers:** 3 ozs (85
Vanna's Choice Yarn: White g) , 145 yards (133 meters)
1 Ball (D) **Twists:** 2.5 oz (70 g), 121 yards (111 meters)
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook -
Size G-6 (4 mm)
- Lion Brand Split Ring
Stitch Markers
- Lion Brand Large-Eye
Blunt Needles (Set of 6)



GAUGE:

16 hdc = about 4 in. (10 cm).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

STITCH EXPLANATION:

sc2tog (sc decrease) Insert hook into st and draw up a loop. Insert hook into next st and draw up a loop. Yarn over, draw through all 3 loops on hook.

NOTES:

1. Hat is worked in one piece. Piece is folded and top and side are seamed to make Hat.
2. To change color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops to complete st. Fasten off old color.

HAT

Beg at top of Hat with A, ch 62 (66, 72, 80).

Row 1: Hdc in 3rd ch from hook (2 skipped ch do not count as a st) and in each ch across – 60 (64, 70, 78) hdc.

Rows 2-4: With A, ch 2 (does not count as a st in this row and in all following rows), turn, hdc in each st across.

Change to B.

Rows 5-17 (18, 19, 21): With B, ch 2, turn, hdc in each st across.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing side and top edges tog.

FINISHING

Fold Hat in half and sew top and side closed.

LARGE EYE

With D, ch 2.

Rnd 1: Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook; do not join, work in continuous rnds.

Place marker in last sc made to indicate end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in each of first 2 sts, 2 hdc in each of next 2 sts, 2 sc in each of last 2 sts – 12 sts at the end of this rnd.

Rnd 3: (2 sc in next st, sc in next st) twice, (2 hdc in next st, hdc in next st) twice, (2 sc in next st, sc in next st) twice; join with sl st in first sc – 18 sts.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Pupil

With A, ch 2.

Rnd 1: Work 8 sc in 2nd ch from hook; join with sl st in first sc – 8 sc.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Sew pupil to Large Eye, then sew Eye to Hat.

SMALL EYE

With D, ch 2.

Rnds 1 and 2: Work same as Rnds 1 and 2 of Large Eye – 12 sts.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Pupil With A, ch 2.

Rnd 1: Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook; join with sl st in first sc – 6 sc.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Sew pupil to Small Eye, then sew Eye to Hat.

BOLTS (make 4)

With C, ch 7.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – 6 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Fasten off.

Sew 1 Bolt across the top of a 2nd Bolt to make a 'T' shape. Rep with remaining 2 Bolts.

Sew a Bolt to each side of Hat.
With A, embroider a straight st mouth and scar onto Hat.
Weave in ends.
