**SKILL LEVEL:** Easy (Level 2)

**SIZE:** One Size

8 x 14 1/2 in. (20.5 x 37 cm)

**CORRECTIONS:** (applied Jan 13, 2015)

**FRONT**

**Row 4:** Ch 2, turn, hdc2tog twice, hdc in each of the next 24 sts, **st across to last st**, 2 hdc in last st – 26 sts.

**LARGE EYE (make 1)**

**Rnd 2:** 2 sc in each of the first 3 sts, 2 hdc in **each of** next 2 sts, 2 sc in each of the last 3 sts – 16 sts.

**MATERIALS**

- 860-100 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: White  
1 Ball (A)
- 860-153 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Black  
1 Ball (B)
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size G-6 (4 mm)
- Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- Additional Materials  
Small amount of fiberfill stuffing

*\*Vanna's Choice® (Article #860). 100% Premium Acrylic  
**400, 401, 403:** 92% Acrylic, 8% Rayon  
**402:** 96% Acrylic, 4% Rayon; package size: **Solids:** 3.5 oz (100 g), 170 yards (156 m)  
**Prints, Tweeds, & Heathers:** 3 ozs (85 g) , 145 yards (133 meters)  
**Twists:** 2.5 oz (70 g), 121 yards (111 meters)*



**GAUGE:**

Exact gauge is not essential to this project.

**STITCH EXPLANATION:**

**hdc2tog (hdc 2 sts together)** (Yarn over, insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 5 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

**NOTES:**

1. Bag is worked in 2 pieces.
2. Handle, Arms and Eyes are worked separately, then sewn to Bag.

**FRONT**

With A, ch 35.

**Row 1:** 2 hdc in the 3rd ch from hook (beg ch does not count as a st), hdc in each of the next 9 ch, (hdc2tog, hdc in each of the next 2 ch) twice, hdc2tog, hdc in each of the next 9 ch sts, hdc2tog twice – 29 sts at the end of this row.

**Row 2:** Ch 2 (does not count as a st in this row or in any of the following rows), turn, hdc2tog twice, hdc in each of the

next 24 sts, 2 hdc in last st – 28 sts.

**Row 3:** Ch 2, turn, 2 hdc in first st, hdc in each of the next 23 sts, hdc2tog twice – 27 sts.

**Row 4:** Ch 2, turn, hdc2tog twice, hdc in each st across to last st, 2 hdc in last st – 26 sts.

**Rows 5-18:** Ch 2, turn, hdc in each hdc across.

**Rows 19-20:** Ch 2, turn, hdc in each of the next 12 sts, sc in next 2 sts, hdc in last 12 sts – 26 sts.

**Rows 21-22:** Ch 2, turn, hdc in each of the next 11 sts, sc in next 4 sts, hdc in last 11 sts.

**Rows 23-24:** Ch 2, turn, hdc in each of the next 10 sts, sc in next 6 sts, hdc in last 10 sts.

**Row 25:** Ch 2, turn, hdc2tog, hdc in each of the next 7 sts, sc in next 8 sts, hdc in last 9 sts – 25 sts.

**Row 26:** Ch 2, turn, hdc2tog, hdc in each of the next 7 sts, sc in next 8 sts, hdc last 8 sts – 24 sts.

**Row 27:** Ch 2, turn, hdc2tog, hdc in each of the next 5 sts, sc in next 10 sts, hdc in last 7 sts – 23 sts.

**Row 28:** Ch 2, turn, hdc2tog, hdc in each of the next 5 sts, sc in next 10 sts, hdc last 6 sts – 22 sts.

**Row 29:** Ch 2, turn, hdc2tog, hdc in each of the next 2 sts, ch 14, sk next 14 sts, hdc in last 4 sts.

**Row 30:** Ch 2, turn, hdc2tog, hdc in each st and ch across – 20 sts.

**Rows 31-34:** Ch 2, turn, hdc2tog, hdc in each st to end of row – 16 sts at the end of Row 34.

**Rows 35 and 36:** Ch 2, turn, hdc2tog, hdc in each st to last 2 sts, hdc2tog – 12 sts at the end of Row 36.  
Fasten off.

## BACK

With A, ch 35.

Work Rows 1-18 of Front.

**Rows 19-24:** Ch 2, turn, hdc in each hdc across – 26 sts.

**Rows 25-34:** Ch 2, turn, hdc2tog, hdc in each st to end of row – 16 sts at the end of Row 34.

**Rows 35 and 36:** Ch 2, turn, hdc2tog, hdc in each st to last 2 sts, hdc2tog – 12 sts at the end of Row 36.  
Fasten off.

## ARMS (make 2)

With A, ch 2.

**Rnd 1:** Work 6 sc in first ch; place a marker to indicate beg of rnd; move marker up as each rnd is completed.

**Rnd 2:** 2 sc in each sc around – 12 sc.

**Rnds 3-10:** Sc in each sc around.

Fasten off.

## LARGE EYE (make 1)

With B, ch 2.

**Rnd 1:** Work 8 sc in first ch; place a marker to indicate beg of rnd; move marker up as each rnd is completed.

**Rnd 2:** 2 sc in each of the first 3 sts, 2 hdc in each of next 2 sts, 2 sc in each of the last 3 sts – 16 sts.

**Rnd 3:** (2 sc in next st, sc in next st) three times, (2 hdc in next st, hdc in next st) twice, (2 sc in next st, sc in next st) three times.

Fasten off.

## SMALL EYE (make 1)

With B, ch 2.

**Rnd 1:** Work 8 sc in first ch; place a marker to indicate beg of rnd; move marker up as each rnd is completed.

**Rnd 2:** 2 sc in each of the first 3 sts, 2 hdc in each of the next 2 sts, 2 sc in each of the last 3 sts – 16 sts.

Fasten off.

## HANDLE

With A, ch 32.

**Row 1:** Hdc in 3rd ch from hook and in each ch across – 30 sts.

**Row 2:** Ch 2, turn, hdc in each st across.

Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Sew eyes to Bag Front.

Hold Front and Back of Bag together. Working through both thicknesses, join A with sl st anywhere along edge. Work sc evenly spaced through both thicknesses around entire outer edge to join. Lightly stuff arms and sew to Bag.

Sew handle to top of Bag.

Weave in ends.
