SKILL LEVEL: Easy + (Level 3)

SIZE: One Size

About 40 x 48 in. (101.5 x 122 cm)

CORRECTIONS: (applied Oct 28, 2014)

Row 38: With B, ch 3, turn, dc in next 15 sts; with D, dc in next 42 sts; with B, dc in next 16 sts; with D, ~~se~~ **dc** in last 42 sts.

Row 68: With B, ch 3, turn, dc in next 15 sts; with F, dc in next 26 sts; with E, dc in next 16 sts; with B, dc in next 16 sts; with F, dc in next 26 sts; with E, dc in last ~~26-16~~ 16 sts.

- 790-368 Lion Brand Homespun Yarn: Montana Sky
1 Ball (A)
- 790-309 Lion Brand Homespun Yarn: Deco
2 Balls (B)
- 790-312 Lion Brand Homespun Yarn: Edwardian
1 Ball (C)
- 790-302 Lion Brand Homespun Yarn: Colonial
1 Ball (D)
- 790-373 Lion Brand Homespun Yarn: Black
1 Ball (E)
- 790-375 Lion Brand Homespun Yarn: Candy Apple
1 Ball (F)
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size K-10.5 (6.5 mm)
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

*Homespun® (Article #790). 98% Acrylic, 2% Polyester;
package size: 6.00oz/170.00 gr. (185yds/169m) pull

GAUGE:

9 1/2 sts + 7 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) over rows.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

1. Afghan is worked in one piece, in alternating rows of sc and dc and changing color to make stripes and blocks of color.

2. Afghan can be worked by following the written instructions or the chart. When working from chart, read RS rows from right to left and WS rows from left to right.
3. To change color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops to complete st. Drop old color to WS of work, but do not fasten off.
4. Do not carry unused color(s) across WS of work. Use a separate ball of yarn for each color section. Before beginning, wind A into 3 separate balls and C, D, E, and F into 2 separate balls each.

AFGHAN

With B, ch 36, with A, ch 22, with a 2nd ball of B ch 36, with a 2nd ball of A, ch 23 – you will have a total of 117 ch.

Row 1 (RS): With A, sc in 2nd ch from hook, and in next 21 ch; with B, sc in next 36 ch; with A, sc in next 22 ch; with B, sc in last 36 ch – you will have 116 sc at the end of this row.

Row 2: With B, ch 3 (counts as first dc in this row and in all following rows), turn, dc in next 35 sts; with A, dc in next 22 sts; with B, dc in next 36 sts; with A, dc in last 22 sts.

Row 3: With A, ch 1, turn, sc in first 22 sts; with B, sc in next 36 sts; with A, sc in next 22 sts; with B, sc in last 36 sts.

Rows 4-7: Rep Rows 2 and 3 twice.

Row 8: Rep Row 2.

Fasten off A and B.

Row 9: With C, ch 1, turn, sc in first 22 sts; with D, sc in next 36 sts; with C, sc in next 22 sts; with D, sc in last 36 sts.

Row 10: With D, ch 3 (counts as first dc in this row and in all following rows), turn, dc in next 35 sts; with C, dc in next 22 sts; with D, dc in next 36 sts; with C, dc in last 22 sts.

Rows 11-18: Rep Rows 9 and 10 four times.

Fasten off C and D.

Row 19: With E, ch 1, turn, sc in first 34 sts; with B, sc in next 24 sts; with E, sc in next 34 sts; with B, sc in last 24 sts.

Row 20: With B, ch 3, turn, dc in next 23 sts; with E, dc in next 34 sts; with B, dc in next 24 sts; with E, dc in last 34 sts.

Rows 21-24: Rep Rows 19 and 20 twice.

Fasten off B and E.

Row 25: With B, ch 1, turn, sc in first 16 sts; with F, sc in next 26 sts; with C, sc in next 16 sts; with B, sc in next 16 sts; with F, sc in next 26 sts; with C, sc in last 16 sts.

Row 26: With C, ch 3, turn, dc in next 15 sts; with F, dc in next 26 sts; with B, dc in next 16 sts; with C, dc in next 16 sts; with F, dc in next 26 sts; with B, dc in last 16 sts.

Rows 27-30: Rep Rows 25 and 26 twice.

Fasten off C, B and F.

Row 31: With C, ch 1, turn, sc in first 24 sts; with E, sc in next 34 sts; with C, sc in next 24 sts; with E, sc in last 34 sts.

Row 32: With E, ch 3, turn, dc in next 33 sts; with C, dc in next 24 sts; with E, dc in next 34 sts; with C, dc in last 24 sts.

Rows 33-36: Rep Rows 31 and 32 twice.

Fasten off C and E.

Row 37: With D, ch 1, turn, sc in first 42 sts; with B, sc in next 16 sts; with D, sc in next 42 sts; with B, sc in last 16 sts.

Row 38: With B, ch 3, turn, dc in next 15 sts; with D, dc in next 42 sts; with B, dc in next 16 sts; with D, dc in last 42 sts.

Rows 39-44: Rep Rows 37 and 38 three times.

Fasten off B and D.

Row 45: With B, ch 1, turn, sc in first 30 sts; with A, sc in next 28 sts; with B, sc in next 30 sts; with A, sc in last 28 sts.

Row 46: With A, ch 3, turn, dc in next 27 sts; with B, dc in next 30 sts; with A, dc in next 28 sts; with B, dc in last 30 sts.

Rows 47 and 48: Rep Rows 45 and 46.

Fasten off B.

Row 49: With A, ch 1, turn, sc in first 22 sts; with B, sc in next 8 sts; with A, sc in next 50 sts; with B, sc in next 8 sts; with A, sc in last 28 sts.

Row 50: With A, ch 3, turn, dc in next 27 sts, fasten off this ball of A; with B, dc in next 8 sts; with A, dc in next 50 sts, fasten off this ball of A; with B, dc in next 8 sts; with A, dc in last 22 sts, do not fasten off this ball of A.

Row 51: With A, ch 1, turn, sc in first 22 sts; with B, sc in next 36 sts; with A sc in next 22 sts; with B, sc in last 36 sts.

Row 52: With B, ch 3, dc in next 35 sts; with A, dc in next 22 sts; with B, dc in next 36 sts; with A, dc in last 22 sts.

Rows 53-58: Rep Rows 51 and 52 three times.

Fasten off A and B.

Row 59: With C, ch 1, turn, sc in first 22 sts; with D, sc in next 36 sts; with C, sc in next 22 sts; with E, sc in last 36 sts.

Row 60: With E, ch 3, turn, dc in next 35 sts; with C, dc in next 22 sts; with D, dc in next 36 sts; with C, dc in last 22 sts.

Rows 61-66: Rep Rows 59 and 60 three times.

Fasten off C and D.

Row 67: With E, ch 1, turn, sc in first 16 sts; with F, sc in next 26 sts; with B, sc in next 16 sts; with E, sc in next 16 sts; with F, sc in next 26 sts; with B, sc in last 16 sts.

Row 68: With B, ch 3, turn, dc in next 15 sts; with F, dc in next 26 sts; with E, dc in next 16 sts; with B, dc in next 16 sts; with F, dc in next 26 sts; with E, dc in last 16 sts.

Rows 69-72: Rep Rows 67 and 68 twice.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
