SKILL LEVEL: Easy (Level 2)

SIZE: 2-3 yrs, Child 3-7, Child 8-10, Small

Child XS (Child S, Child M, Child L/Adult S)

Finished Circumference About 15 (16, 17 1/2, 19 1/2) in. (38 (40.5, 44.5, 49.5) cm), will stretch to fit a range of sizes

Note: Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

MATERIALS

- 860-153 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice

Yarn: Black

1 Ball (A)

- 860-149 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice

Yarn: Silver Grey

1 Ball (B)

- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size G-6 (4 mm)

- Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers

- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

- Additional Materials

Small amount of red yarn

Fiberfill stuffing

**Vanna's Choice® (Article #860). 100% Premium Acrylic*

400, 401, 403: 92% Acrylic, 8% Rayon

402: 96% Acrylic, 4% Rayon; package size:

Solids: 3.5 oz (100 g), 170 yards (156 m)

Prints, Tweeds, & Heathers: 3 ozs (85 g) , 145 yards (133 meters)

Twists: 2.5 oz (70 g), 121 yards (111 meters)



GAUGE:

16 hdc = about 4 in. (10 cm).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

1. Hat is worked in one piece in continuous rnds. Do not join and do not turn rnds.
2. Spider Head, Eyes and Legs are worked separately and sewn to Hat.

HAT

With A, ch 2.

Rnd 1: Work 8 sc in 2nd ch from hook do not join, work in continuous rnds. Place a marker in last sc made to indicate end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: Work 2 hdc in each st around - 16 hdc at the end of this rnd.

Rnd 3: * 2 hdc in next st, hdc in next st rep from * around - 24 hdc.

Rnd 4: * 2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 2 sts rep from * around - 32 hdc.

Rnd 5: * 2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 3 sts rep from * around - 40 hdc.

Rnd 6: * 2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 4 sts rep from * around - 48 hdc.

Rnd 7: * 2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 5 sts rep from * around – 56 hdc.

Rnd 8: * 2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 13 (6, 6, 6) sts rep from * around – 60 (64, 64, 64) hdc.

Size Child M ONLY:

Rnd 9: (2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 10 sts) 5 times, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in last 8 sts – 70 hdc.

Size Child L/Adult S ONLY:

Rnd 9: * 2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 7 sts rep from * around – 72 hdc.

Rnd 10: * 2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 11 sts rep from * around – 78 hdc.

All Sizes:

Next 9 (10, 10, 11) Rnds: Hdc in each st around.

Sl st in next hdc. Fasten off.

SPIDER

With A, ch 2.

Rnd 1: Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook do not join, work in continuous rnds.

Place a marker in last sc made to indicate end of rnd.

Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in each st around – 12 sc at the end of this rnd.

Rnd 3: * 2 sc in next st, sc in next st rep from * around – 18 sc.

Rnd 4: * 2 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts rep from * around – 24 sc.

Rnd 5: * 2 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts rep from * around – 30 sc.

Rnd 6: * 2 sc in next st, sc in next 4 sts rep from * around – 36 sc.

Rnds 7-10: Sc in each st around.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail for sewing.

EYES (make 2)

With B, ch 2.

Rnd 1: Work 5 sc in 2nd ch from hook join with sl st in first sc – 5 sc.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail for sewing.

LEGS (make 8)

With A, ch 22.

Row 1: Hdc in 3rd ch from hook and in each ch across – 20 hdc.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail for sewing. Tie each leg into a knot, with the knot at center of leg.

FINISHING

With red yarn, embroider straight st mouth on Spider. Sew eyes to Spider. Stuff Spider and sew to center front of Hat.

Sew Legs to sides of Hat.

Weave in ends.
