MATERIALS

- 860-153 [Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Black](#)
1 Ball (A)
- 861-134 [Lion Brand Vanna's Glamour Yarn: Copper](#)
1 Ball (B)
- [Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size G-6 \(4 mm\)](#)

Sewing needle and thread

**Vanna's Choice® (Article #860). 100% Premium Acrylic*

400, 401, 403: 92% Acrylic, 8% Rayon

402: 96% Acrylic, 4% Rayon; package size: **Solids:** 3.5 oz (100 g), 170 yards (156 m)

Prints, Tweeds, & Heathers: 3 ozs (85 g) , 145 yards (133 meters)

Twists: 2.5 oz (70 g), 121 yards (111 meters)

**Vanna's Glamour (Article #861). 96% Acrylic, 4% Metallic*

Polyester; package size: 1.75oz/49.61 gr. (202yds/185m) pull skeins



GAUGE:

22 sc + 29 rows = about 8 in. (20.5 cm) with larger hook.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

STITCH EXPLANATION:

sc2tog (sc 2 sts together) (Insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

NOTES:

Cat face is crocheted, then sewed to purchased t-shirt.

CAT

With larger hook and A, ch 3; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 3 (counts as first dc in this rnd and in all following rnds), 11 dc in ring; join with sl st in top of beg ch – 12 dc.

Rnd 2: Ch 3, dc in same st as joining, 2 dc in each dc around; join with sl st in top of beg ch – 24 dc at the end of this rnd.

Rnd 3: Ch 3, dc in same st as joining, dc in next dc, *2 dc in next dc, dc in next dc; rep from * around; join with sl st in top of beg ch – 36 dc. Do not fasten off.

First Ear

Row 1 (RS): Ch 1, sc in same st as joining, sc in next 5 dc; leave rem sts unworked – 6 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in next 2 sts, sc2tog – 4 sc.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, (sc2tog) twice – 2 sc.

Row 4: Ch 1, turn, sc2tog – 1 sc.

Fasten off.

Second Ear

Row 1 (RS): From RS, sk next 2 unworked sts following First Ear, join A with sc in next st, sc in next 5 dc; leave rem sts unworked – 6 sc.

Rows 2-4: Work same as Rows 2-4 of First Ear. Do not fasten off.

Edging: Ch 1, turn, 3 sc in sc, work sc evenly spaced around entire outside edge of Cat, working 3 sc in tip of each ear; join with sl st in first sc.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Eyes (make 2)

With smaller hook and C, ch 3; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 1, work 8 sc in ring; join with sl st in first sc – 8 sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in same st as joining, ch 1, dc in next sc, ch 1, sc in next sc, sl st in next sc, ch 1, sc in next sc, ch 1, dc in next sc, ch 1, sc in next sc, sl st in next sc; join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Sew eyes to Cat.

With sewing needle and thread, sew Cat to shirt.

Weave in ends.
