MATERIALS

 497-asstd <u>Lion Brand LB</u> <u>Collection Silk Chiffon Ribbon</u>
 2 Balls

 <u>Lion Brand Knitting Needles -</u> Size 17 [13 mm]

- <u>Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt</u> <u>Needles (Set of 6)</u>
- Additional Materials
 Sewing needle and thread

*LB Collection Silk Chiffon Ribbon (Article #497). 100% silk; package size: 3.50oz/100.00 gr. (90yds/82m) pull skeins



GAUGE:

6 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) over Rows 1 and 2.

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

STITCH EXPLANATION:

yo (yarn over)

An increase that also creates a small decorative hole (eyelet) in the fabric, worked as follows:

- 1. Bring yarn to front, between the needles.
- 2. Take yarn to back, over the right needle. This creates the new st. You are now ready to proceed with the next st as instructed.

NOTES:

The yo's (yarn over's) that are worked in Row 1 are dropped in Row 2. To drop the yo, purl until the yo is the next loop on your left hand needle, then drop the loop by simply sliding it off your left hand needle. This creates long strands of yarn across your work.

COWL

Cast on 15 sts.

Row 1: K1, *yo, k1; repeat across.

Row 2: Purl across row, dropping all of the yos.

Rep Rows 1-2 until piece measures about 60 in. (152.5 cm) from beg.

Bind off.

FINISHING

Lay piece flat. Turn one of the ends over (180 degree turn) to put a twist in the piece. Keeping the twist, sew ends together with sewing needle and thread.

Weave in yarn ends.
