- 605-146 Lion Brand Glitterspun: Rose Quartz 1 Ball (A)
- 605-173 Lion Brand Glitterspun: Emerald 1 Ball (B)
- Additional Materials Card stock in color of your choice Craft knife, metal ruler and cutting mat Pencil Sharp embroidery needle Craft glue

*Glitterspun (Article #605). 80% Polyester, 20% Nylon; package size: 0.00oz/0.00 gr. (16yds/5m) pull skeins



MATERIALS NOTE

Materials are sufficient to make multiple Place Cards.

GAUGE:

Exact gauge is not essential to this project.

PLACE CARD

With craft knife and ruler, and working on a cutting mat, cut card stock to desired size. Fold each piece of card stock in half to make place card. Embroidery can be worked freehand, or you can lightly sketch a simple design onto the front of each card, then embroider over your pencil lines.

Thread desired color of GLITTERSPUN® into sharp embroidery needle and draw threaded needle through front of Place Card. Embroider straight stitches and French knots as desired onto front of card, using embroidery needle to pierce through the card.

When you've finished embroidering, draw needle back through to the back side of the card.

FINISHING

Trim ribbon ends on the inside of the card. Apply a small amount of glue to each ribbon end, and glue to card.
