MATERIALS

- 605-170 Lion Brand Glitterspun: Gold
1 Ball (A)
- 605-150 Lion Brand Glitterspun: Silver
1 Ball (B)
- 605-134 Lion Brand Glitterspun: Copper
1 Ball (C)
- 605-113 Lion Brand Glitterspun: Ruby
1 Ball (D)
- 605-148 Lion Brand Glitterspun: Turquoise
1 Ball (E)
- Additional Materials
Purchased barrettes, with double metal bar

**Glitterspun (Article #605). 80% Polyester, 20% Nylon; package size: 0.00oz/0.00 gr. (16yds/5m) pull skeins*



MATERIALS NOTES

1. Materials are sufficient to make multiple Barrettes.
2. Barrettes are made using 2 colors. For each Barrette or pair of Barrettes, choose any colors you like to be first and second colors.

GAUGE:

Exact gauge is not essential to this project.

BARRETTE (make 2)

(Samples were made with A and B; C and D; A and E)
Cut a 40 in. (101.5 cm) length of each of any 2 colors.

1. Place first color on top of second color, with ends lined up. Keeping edges of ribbons lined up, place the center of the ribbons under the double bars at the clasp end of the Barrette. For purposes of this pattern, consider the layers of ribbon on the right hand side of the Barrette as Ribbon 1 and the left hand side layers, Ribbon 2. Ribbons 1 and 2 will be woven over and under the bars of the Barrette.
2. Begin weaving by folding Ribbon 1 over the right hand bar of the Barrette and then under the left hand bar, so that Ribbon 1 covers the right hand bar of the Barrette – second color shows on the right hand bar of the Barrette.

3. Both Ribbons 1 and 2 are now on the left hand side of the Barrette. Fold Ribbon 2 over the left hand bar of the Barrette and then under the right hand bar.
Ribbon 1 is now on the left hand side of the Barrette and Ribbon 2 is on the right hand side of the Barrette – second color shows on the left hand bar of the Barrette.
4. Fold Ribbon 2 over the right hand bar and then under the left hand bar of the Barrette – first color shows on the right hand bar of the Barrette.
5. Fold Ribbon 1 over the left hand bar and then under the right hand bar of the Barrette – first color shows on the left hand bar of the Barrette.
6. Repeat steps 4 and 5 until entire Barrette is covered - first and second colors will alternate to make stripes on the Barrette.

FINISHING

Knot the yarn ends together at base of Barrette. Trim strands to desired length and knot end of each strand.
