CORRECTIONS: (applied Jan 13, 2015)

Upper section

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Row 2: Ch 2 (does not count as an hdc), turn, working through back loops only, hdc in each st

across.

#### **MATERIALS**

 134-243 <u>Lion Brand</u> <u>Country: Lobster</u>

 Ball

<u>Lion Brand Crochet Hook</u>
 Size N-13 (9 mm)

• <u>Lion Brand Large-Eye</u> Blunt Needles (Set of 6) \*Country (Article #134). 100% acrylic; package size: 5.00oz/141.75 gr. (156yds/143m) pull skeins



# **GAUGE:**

8 hdc tbl = about 4 in. (10 cm).

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

#### **NOTES:**

- 1. Upper section of Cowl is worked back and forth in rows, then joined to make a ring.
- 2. Stitches are worked along one edge of the upper section to work the lower section.

# COWL

# **Upper section**

Ch 12

**Row 1:** Hdc in 3rd ch from hook and each ch across – 10 hdc.

**Row 2:** Ch 2 (does not count as an hdc), turn, working through back loops only, hdc in each st across. Rep Row 2 until piece measures about 20 in. (51 cm) from beg.

Joining Row: Fold piece with RS together and sts from first and last rows aligned.

Ch 1, working through both thicknesses, slip st in each st across to join.

Do NOT fasten off.

### Lower section

Row 1 (RS): From RS, ch 1, work 40 sc evenly spaced around lower edge of Cowl.

**Row 2:** Ch 6 (for tab), turn, hdc in 3rd ch from hook (beg ch-2 does not count as a st) and in each ch and sc across – 44 sts.

Rows 3-5: Ch 2, turn, working through back loops only, hdc in each st across.

Rows 6 and 7: Ch 1, turn, working through back loops only, sc in each st across. Fasten off.

#### **FINISHING**

Place tab behind beg of row and tack in place at beg of lower section. Weave in ends.
