• 630-155 <u>Lion Brand Wool-Ease</u> <u>Chunky Yarn: Silver Grey</u>

1 Ball (A)

• 630-152 <u>Lion Brand Wool-Ease</u> <u>Chunky Yarn: Charcoal</u>

1 Ball (B)

- <u>Lion Brand Crochet Hook Size N-13 (9 mm)</u>
- <u>Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt</u> Needles (Set of 6)

\*<u>Wool-Ease Chunky</u> (Article #630). **Solids:** 80% Acrylic, 20% Wool;

**301 Tinsel White:** 78% Acrylic, 19% Wool, 3% Other; **402 Wheat:** 86% Acrylic, 10% Wool, 4% Other; package size: 5.00oz/140.00 gr. (153yds/140m) pull skeins



# **GAUGE:**

 $9 \text{ dc} + 5 \frac{1}{2} \text{ rows} = \text{about 4 in. (10 cm)}.$ 

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

#### **NOTES:**

- 1. Cowl is made in two halves then sewn together.
- 2. A larger hook was used for this design to create a more open stitch pattern.

#### COWL

## **First Half**

With A, ch 22.

Row 1: Dc in 4th ch from hook (beg ch counts as first dc) and in each ch across - 20 dc.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, dc next st and in each st across – 20 dc.

Rows 3-16: Rep Row 2.

Change to B.

Rows 17-32: With B, rep Row 2.

Fasten off.

# Second Half

With A, ch 62.

Row 1: Dc in 4th ch from hook (beg ch counts as first dc) and in each ch across - 60 dc.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, dc in next st and in each st across - 60 dc.

**Rows 3-6:** Rep Row 2.

Change to B.

Rows 7-12: With B, rep Row 2.

Fasten off.

# **FINISHING**

Sew short ends of both halves together to make Cowl. Weave in ends.
