\*Homespun® (Article #790). 98% Acrylic, 2% Polyester; package size: 6.00oz/170.00 gr. (185yds/169m) pull

#### **MATERIALS**

- 790-329 <u>Lion Brand</u> <u>Homespun Yarn: Waterfall</u>
   4 Balls (A)
- 320-100 <u>Lion Brand Fun Fur Yarn: White</u>
  - 2 Balls (B)
- <u>Lion Brand Crochet Hook -</u> <u>Size K-10.5 (6.5 mm)</u>
- <u>Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt</u> <u>Needles (Set of 6)</u>

\*Fun Fur (Article #320). 100% Polyester; package size:

**Solids:** 1.75 oz/50g; 64 yd/58m balls **Prints:** 1.5 oz/40g; 57 yd/52m balls

Exotics: 1.75 oz/50g; 55 yd/50m balls (Note: Exotics

shades are lay flat to dry)





#### **GAUGE:**

10 hdc = about 4 in. (10 cm) with A.

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

### NOTES:

Throw is worked is worked in one piece, then a border is worked around the outside edge.



#### **THROW**

With A, ch 92.

**Row 1:** Hdc in 3rd ch from hook (the 2 skipped ch do not count as a st) and in each ch across – you will have 90 hdc at the end of this row.

Row 2: Ch 2 (ch 2 does not count as a st), turn, hdc in each st across.

Repeat Row 2 until almost all of A has been used.

Fasten off.

## **FINISHING**

#### **Border**

Join B with a sl st anywhere along outside edge of Throw.

**Round 1:** Ch 2, work hdc evenly spaced around entire outer edge of Throw, working 3 hdc in each corner; join with sl st in top of beginning ch.

**Rounds 2 and 3:** Ch 2, hdc in each hdc around, working 3 hdc in center st at each corner; join with sl st in top of beginning ch.

Fasten off.

Weave in ends.
