**SKILL LEVEL:** Easy (Level 2)

**SIZE:** One Size

About 8 x 72 in. (20.5 x 183 cm)

#### **MATERIALS**

- 755-210 Lion Brand Unique Yarn: Circus  
3 Balls
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size N-13 (9 mm)
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

*\*Unique (Article #755). 100% Acrylic; package size: 3.50oz/100.00 gr. (109yds/100m) pull skeins*



#### **GAUGE:**

3 V-sts + 6 1/2 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm)

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

#### **STITCH EXPLANATION:**

**V-st (V-stitch)** (Dc, ch 1, dc) in indicated st or sp.

#### **SCARF**

Ch 22.

**Row 1:** V-st in 5th ch from hook (4 skipped ch count as 1 foundation ch and first dc), \*sk next 2 ch, V-st in next ch; rep from \* to last 2 ch, sk next ch, dc in last ch – you will have 6 V-sts at the end of this row.

**Row 2:** Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), turn, hdc in sp between first dc and first V-st, \*ch 1, 2 hdc in next sp between V-sts; rep from \* to beg ch-sp, 2 hdc in beg ch-sp – 14 hdc (seven 2-hdc groups) and 6 ch-1 sps.

**Row 3:** Ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, V-st in each ch-1 sp across, dc in top of beg ch – 6 V-sts. Rep Rows 2 and 3 until piece measures about 72 in. (183 cm) from beg or until all yarn is used. Fasten off.

#### **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.
