Free Knitting Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn

Lion Brand® Heartland® - Pelt

Bristol Bay Hat

Pattern Number: L40302

SKILL LEVEL: Easy + (Level 3)

SIZE: One Size

Finished Circumference About 21 in. (53.5 cm)

CORRECTIONS: (applied Dec 23, 2016)

... **Dec Rnd 2:** **K2**, *K2tog; rep from * around - 24 **22** sts.

Next Rnd: *K1, p1; rep from * around.

Next Rnd: Knit.

Rep last 2 rnds twice more.

Dec Rnd 3: *K2tog; rep from * ~~to last st, k1~~ **around** - 11 sts.

Knit 1 rnd.

Dec Rnd 4: ~~Rep Dec Rnd 3~~ *K2tog; rep from * **to last st, k1** - 6 sts.

MATERIALS

- 136-125 Lion Brand Heartland Yarn: Mammoth Cave

2 Balls (A)

- 321-203 Lion Brand Pelt: Fisher

2 Balls (B)

- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size J-10 (6 mm)

- Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers

- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

- Additional Materials

Circular knitting needle size 10.5 (6.5 mm), 16 in. (40.5 cm) long

Double pointed knitting needles size 10.5 (6.5 mm), set of 5

Heartland (Article #136). **Solids: 100% Acrylic*

***Tweeds:** 94% Acrylic, 6% Rayon; package size: **Solids:** 5oz/142g (251yd/230m)*

***Tweeds:** 4oz/113g (200yd/183m)*

**Pelt (Article #321). 68% Nylon, 32% Polyester; package size: 1.75oz/50.00 gr. (47yds/43m) pull skeins*



GAUGE:

12 sts = 4 in. (10 cm) over Rnds 1 and 2 with 2 strands of A held tog.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

1. Hat is worked in the rnd.
2. Earflaps are worked separately and sewn to Hat.

HAT

With circular knitting needle and two strands of A held together, loosely cast on 63 sts. Place marker for beg of rnd and join by working the first st on the left hand needle with the working yarn from the right hand need, being careful not to twist sts.

Rnd 1: *K1, p2; rep from * around.

Rnd 2: Knit.

Rep Rnds 1 and 2 until piece measures 5 in. (12.5 cm) from beg, ending with Rnd 1 as the last rnd you work.

Note: As you work the next row, change to double pointed needles (dpns) as follows:

Dec Rnd 1: With first needle, (k1, k2tog) 5 times, k1; with second needle, (k2tog, k1) 5 times; with third needle (k2tog, k1) 5 times, k2tog; with fourth needle, (k1, k2tog) 5 times; replace beg of rnd marker – 42 sts at the end of this rnd (11 sts on first and third needles, 10 sts on second and fourth needles).

Next Rnd: *K1, p1; rep from * around.

Next Rnd: Knit.

Rep last 2 rnds twice more.

Dec Rnd 2: K2, *k2tog; rep from * around – 22 sts.

Next Rnd: *K1, p1; rep from * around.

Next Rnd: Knit.

Rep last 2 rnds twice more.

Dec Rnd 3: *K2tog; rep from * around – 11 sts.

Knit 1 rnd.

Dec Rnd 4: K2tog; rep from * to last st, k1 – 6 sts.

Cut yarn, leaving a long yarn tail. Thread yarn tail through rem sts and pull to gather. Knot securely.

Earflaps (make 2 with 2 strands of A held tog, and 3 with 1 strand of B)

With circular knitting needle, loosely cast on 34 sts. Work back and forth on circular needle as if working on straight needles.

Rows 1-4: Knit.

Row 5: K 17, place marker, k 17.

Row 6: K2tog, k to 2 sts before marker, k2tog, slip marker, k2tog, k to last 2 sts, k2tog.

Row 7: Knit.

Rep Rows 6 and 7 until 6 sts rem.

Remove marker.

Next Row: K1, (k2tog) twice, k1 – 4 sts.

Next Row: (K2tog) twice – 2 sts.

Bind off.

FINISHING

Place a marker at center back (beg/end of rnds), then place markers 1 1/2 in. (4 cm) and 7 1/2 in. (19 cm) to right and left of center back marker for earflap placement. Remove center back marker.

Sew one long straight edge of one A earflap between each set of markers. Sew one B earflap to the inside of each of A earflap. Sew remaining B earflap upside-down to top front of Hat, having long straight edge of earflap even with front edge of Hat.

Ties

With crochet hook and 2 strands of A held tog, ch for 12 in. (30.5 cm). Cut leaving a long yarn tail.

Cut six 10 in. (25.5 cm) strands of B. Holding 5 of the B strands tog, tie at center with long yarn tail of tie.

Fold strands in half, and use rem B strand to tie around tassel about 1 in. (2.5 cm) from fold. Thread ends of yarn to center of tassel to hide and trim tassel ends evenly. Attach opposite end of tie to bottom of

earflap. Rep for opposite earflap.
Weave in ends.
