SKILL LEVEL: Easy (Level 2)

SIZE: Child (Multiple Sizes), Adult (Multiple Sizes)

Child S (Child M/L, Adult S/M, Adult L)

Finished circumference 16 (18, 20, 22) in. (40.5 (46, 51, 56) cm), will stretch to fit a range of sizes.

Note: Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

MATERIALS

- 640-123 [Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick & Quick Yarn: Oatmeal](#)
1 Ball (A)
- 320-216 [Lion Brand Fun Fur Yarn: Ginger](#)
1 Ball (B)
- [Brittany Birchwood Double Pointed Needles - Size 13](#)
- [Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers](#)
- [Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles \(Set of 6\)](#)
- Additional Materials
1 1/2 X 4 in. (4 X 10 cm) piece of cardboard

**Wool-Ease Thick & Quick (Article #640).
Solids, Heathers, Twists: 80% Acrylic, 20% Wool
Wheat & Wood: 86% Acrylic; 10% Wool; 4% Rayon
Oatmeal & Barley & Grey Marble: 82% Acrylic; 10% Wool; 8% Rayon
Metallics: 79% Acrylic, 20% Wool, 1% Metallic Poly; package size: Solids, Heathers, Twists, Tweeds: 6 oz./170g (106 yd/97 m)
Prints, Stripes: 5 oz./140g (87 yd/80 m)
Metallics: 5 oz./140g (92 yd/84 m)*

**Fun Fur (Article #320). 100% Polyester;
package size: **Solids:** 1.75 oz/50g; 64 yd/58m balls
Prints: 1.5 oz/40g; 57 yd/52m balls
Exotics: 1.75 oz/50g; 55 yd/50m balls
(**Note:** Exotics shades are lay flat to dry)*



GAUGE:

9 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) in St st worked in rnds (k every rnd).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

1. Hat is worked in the round with double pointed needles.
2. Yarn B is worked with 3 strands held together. Wind B into 3 separate balls before beginning.
3. When the instructions say to repeat an action 0 times, this means that for your specific size, you will not need to work any repeats.

HAT

With A, cast on 36 (40, 44, 48) sts. Divide sts onto 4 needles, placing 9 (10, 11, 12) sts on each needle. Place marker for beg of rnd. Join by working the first st on left hand needle with the working yarn from the right hand needle and being careful not to twist sts.

Rnd 1: *K2, p2; rep from * to end of rnd. Change to 3 strands of B held together. Do not cut A, simply carry the strand up the WS of the Hat.

Rnds 2 and 3: With 3 strands of B held together, work in St st worked in rnds (k every rnd). Change to A. Do not cut the 3 strands of B, simply carry the strands up the WS of the Hat.

Rnds 4 and 5: With A, work in St st. Change to 3 strands of B held together. Do not cut A, simply carry the strand up the WS of the Hat.

Next 4 Rnds: Rep last 4 rnds 0 (0, 1, 1) time.

Next Rnd: With 3 strands of B held together, knit.

Change to A.

Next 2 Rnds: With A, knit. Change to 3 strands of B held together.

Next Rnd: With 3 strands of B held together, knit. Change to A.

With A, work in St st until piece measures about 7 (7, 8 1/2, 8 1/2) in. (18 (18, 21.5, 21.5) cm) from beg.

Shape Crown (Top of Hat)

Dec Rnd: K2tog around – 18 (20, 22, 24) sts.

Cut yarn, leaving a long yarn tail. Thread yarn tail through remaining sts and pull to gather. Knot securely.

FINISHING

Tassel (make 2 (2, 3, 3))

Wrap A around the 1 1/2 in. (4 cm) side of cardboard 5 times. Cut a 20 in. (51 cm) length of A and thread doubled into blunt needle. Insert needle under all strands at upper edge of cardboard. Pull tightly and knot securely near strands. Cut yarn loops at lower edge of cardboard.

Cut a 16 in. (40.5 cm) length of B and wrap tightly around loops about 1/2 in. (1.5 cm) below top knot to form tassel neck. Knot securely; thread ends of B onto needle and weave into center of tassel. Trim tassel ends evenly. Use ends of A to tie tassel to top of Hat.

Weave in ends.
