SKILL LEVEL: Easy (Level 2)

SIZE: Small, Medium, Large, 1X, 2X/3X

S (M, L, 1X, 2X/3X)

Finished Bust (closed) 38 (42, 47, 51, 57) in. (96.5 (106.5, 119.5, 129.5, 145) cm)

Finished Length 26 (26, 27, 28, 28) in. (66 (66, 68.5, 71, 71) cm), not including collar

Note: Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

MATERIALS

- 755-205 Lion Brand Unique Yarn:
Grapevine

**Unique (Article #755). 100% Acrylic; package size:
3.50oz/100.00 gr. (109yds/100m) pull skeins*



- 9 10, 12, 13, 14 Balls
- Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers
- Lion Brand Stitch Holders
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles
(Set of 6)
- Additional Materials
Circular knitting needle size 9 (5.5 mm),
60 in. (152.5 cm) long

GAUGE:

13 sts + 22 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Seed st.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

PATTERN STITCH

Seed St (worked over an odd number of sts)

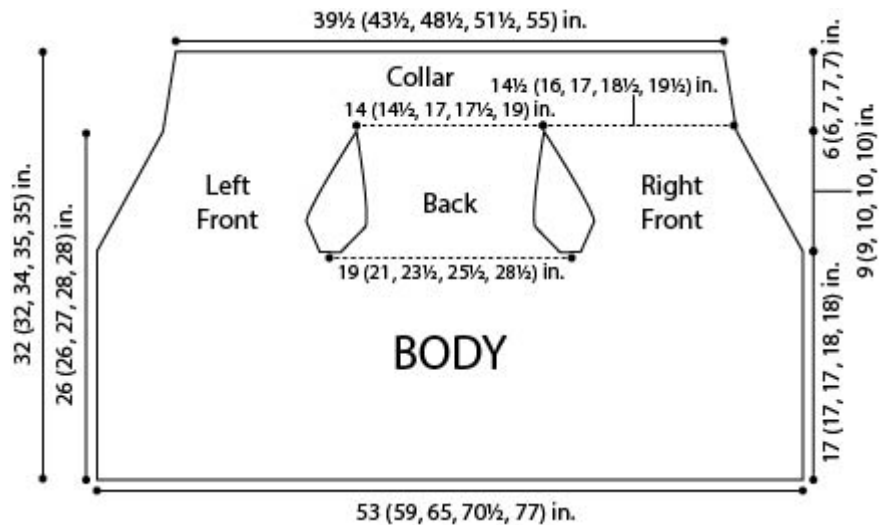
Row 1 (RS): *K1, p1; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 2: K the purl sts and p the knit sts.

Rep Row 2 for Seed st.

NOTES:

1. Vest is worked in one piece beg at lower edge. Piece is divided at armholes and fronts and back are worked separately to shoulders.
2. At shoulders, fronts and back are joined to work collar.
3. A circular needle is used to accommodate the large number of sts. Work back and forth on circular needle as if working on straight needles.
4. When you see 'work even' in the instructions, this means to continue on in the pattern st you have established without changing the st count by increasing, decreasing, or binding off.



BODY

Cast on 173 (191, 211, 229, 251) sts.

Beg with Row 1, work in Seed st until piece measures about 17 (17, 17, 18, 18) in. (43 (43, 43, 45.5, 45.5) cm) from beg, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Divide for Armholes

Next Row (RS): Work in Seed st over first 53 (59, 63, 68, 73) sts for right front and sl to a holder; bind off next 5 (6, 8, 10, 13) sts for armhole; work in Seed st over next 57 (61, 69, 73, 79) sts for back and sl to a holder; bind off next 5 (6, 8, 10, 13) sts for armhole; work in Seed st to end – 53 (59, 63, 68, 73) sts rem for left front.

Left Front

Row 1 Decrease (WS): Work in Seed st to last 3 sts of left front, p2tog, k1 – 52 (58, 62, 67, 72) sts at the end of this row.

Next Row: Work in Seed st across.

Decrease Row: Rep Row 1 – 51 (57, 61, 66, 71) sts.

Rep last 2 rows 4 (5, 5, 6, 7) more times – 47 (52, 56, 60, 64) sts when all decreases have been completed.

Work even in Seed st until piece measures about 9 (9, 10, 10, 10) in. (23 (23, 25.5, 25.5, 25.5) cm) from divide, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Cut yarn and sl sts to a holder.

Back

Sl 57 (61, 69, 73, 79) back sts from holder back to needle and join yarn, ready to work a WS row.

Decrease Row (WS): K1, p2tog, work in Seed st to last 3 sts, p2tog, k1 – 55 (59, 67, 71, 77) sts.

Next Row: Work in Seed st across.

Rep last 2 rows 5 (6, 6, 7, 8) more times – 45 (47, 55, 57, 61) sts when all decreases have been completed.

Work even in Seed st until back measures same as left front, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Cut yarn and sl sts to a holder.

Right Front

Sl 53 (59, 63, 68, 73) right front sts back to needle and join yarn, ready to work a WS row.

Decrease Row (WS): K1, p2tog, work in Seed st to end of row – 52 (58, 62, 67, 72) sts.

Next Row: Work in Seed st across.

Rep last 2 rows 5 (6, 6, 7, 8) more times – 47 (52, 56, 60, 64) sts when all decreases have been completed.

Work even in Seed st until right front measures same as back, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Sl sts for back and then sts for left front back onto other end of needle, ready to work a RS row.

Joining Row (RS): Work in Seed st to last st of right front, k2tog (last st of right front and first st of back), place marker (pm), work in Seed st to last st of back, k2tog tog (last st of back and first st of left front), pm, work in Seed st to end of left front – 137 (149, 165, 175, 187) sts.

Shape Collar

Slipping markers as you come to them, work even in Seed st until about 2 in. (5 cm) from joining row, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Decrease Row 1 (RS): Working in Seed st as established, work to 2 sts before first marker, k2tog, slip marker (sm), p2tog, work to 2 sts before next marker, k2tog, sm, p2tog, work to end of row – 133 (145, 161, 171, 183) sts.

Work even in Seed st until about 4 in. (10 cm) from joining row, end with a WS row.

Decrease Row 2 (RS): Working in Seed st as established, work to 2 sts before first marker, p2tog, remove marker,

k2tog, work to 2 sts before 2nd marker, p2tog, remove marker, k2tog, work to end of row – 129 (141, 157, 167, 179) sts.

Work even in Seed st until about 6 (6, 7, 7, 7) in. (15 (15, 17.5, 17.5, 17.5) cm) from joining row.

Bind off in Seed st.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
