

#### GAUGE:

6 1/2 sc = about 4 in. (10 cm) over Row 2.

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

#### NOTES:

1. Scarfie is worked in 2 pieces: Scarfie and Tab. The Tab is worked first so that all remaining yarn can be used for the Scarfie.

2. Follow the diagram for where to sew the Tab. Thread end of Scarfie through Tab to wear.



#### TAB

Ch 5.

**Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and each in ch across – 4 sc. **Rows 2-11:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across. Fasten off.

#### SCARFIE

Ch 18.

**Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook, ch 3, sc in next ch, \*sk next ch, sc in next ch, ch 3, sc in next ch; rep from \* across – at the end of Row 1 you will have 6 ch-3 sps.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, (sc, ch 3, sc) in each ch-3 sp across.

Rep Row 2 until piece measures about 45 in. (114.5 cm) from beginning or until only a few yards (meters) of yarn remains.

Fasten off.

**Trim** From RS, working across opposite side of foundation ch, join yarn with sc in ch at base of first sc, ch 3, sc in ch at base of next st, \*sk next ch, sc in ch at base of next st, ch 3, sc in ch at base of next st; rep from \* across – 6 ch-3 sps.

Fasten off.

### FINISHING

**Note:** Scarfie and Tab are both reversible, there is no right side. Following diagram, sew Tab to Scarfie. Weave in ends.
