# Free Crochet Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn

## Lion Brand® Homespun®

### Blue Streak Shawl

**SKILL LEVEL:** Easy (Level 2)

**SIZE:** One Size

**Finished Length** About 68 in. (172.5 cm)

**Finished Width** About 13 1/2 in. (34.5 cm)

#### **MATERIALS**

- 790-373 Lion Brand Homespun Yarn: Black  
2 Balls (A) *\*Homespun® (Article #790). 98% Acrylic, 2% Polyester; package size: 6.00oz/170.00 gr. (185yds/169m) pull skeins*
- 790-368 Lion Brand Homespun Yarn: Montana Sky  
1 Ball (B)
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size I-9
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)



#### **GAUGE:**

1 ripple = about 4 1/4 in. (11 cm), measured from peak to peak.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

#### **STITCH EXPLANATION:**

**dc2tog (dc 2 sts together)** (Yarn over, insert hook in next st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

**sc2tog (sc 2 sts together)** (Insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

#### **NOTES:**

1. Shawl is worked lengthwise using a hook slightly smaller than usually recommended for this yarn. Using a smaller hook means your sts will be a bit tighter, and this helps the ripples hold their shape.

2. The ripple in this design is created by working dc2tog or sc2tog to form 'valleys' and 2 dc or 2 sc in each of 2 sts to form 'peaks'. In each row, take care to work dc2tog or sc2tog over the 4 sts in each 'valley' and 2 dc or 2 sc in the 2 center sts of each 'peak.' You may wish to use stitch markers to mark each peak.
3. To change color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete the st. Fasten off old color. Proceed with new color.

## SHAWL

With A, ch 195.

**Row 1:** Dc in 4th ch from hook (beg ch counts as first dc), \*dc in next 3 ch, (dc2tog) twice, dc in next 3 ch, 2 dc in each of next 2 ch; rep from \* to last 11 ch, dc in next 3 ch, (dc2tog) twice, dc in next 3 ch, 2 dc in last ch – 16 ripples.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, \*sc in next 3 sts, (sc2tog) twice, sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in each of next 2 sts; rep from \* to last 11 sts, sc in next 3 sts, (sc2tog) twice, sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in top of beg ch-3.

**Row 3:** Ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, dc in first st, \*dc in next 3 sts, (dc2tog) twice, dc in next 3 sts, 2 dc in each of next 2 sts; rep from \* to last 11 sts, dc in next 3 sts, (dc2tog) twice, dc in next 3 sts, 2 dc in last st.

Rep last 2 rows until piece measures about 9 in. (23 cm) from beg, change to B in last st of last row.

With B, continue to rep last 2 rows until piece measures about 13 1/2 in. (34.5 cm) from beg.

Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.
