SKILL LEVEL: Easy + (Level 3)

SIZE: One Size

Finished Circumference 19 in. (48.5 cm), Hat will stretch to fit a range of sizes.

MATERIALS

- 790-322 [Lion Brand Homespun Yarn: Baroque](#) 1 Ball **Homespun® (Article #790). 98% Acrylic, 2% Polyester; package size: 6.00oz/170.00 gr. (185yds/169m) pull skeins*
- [Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size N-13 \(9 mm\)](#)
- [Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles \(Set of 6\)](#)



GAUGE:

7 sts = 4 in. (10 cm).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

HAT

Ch 35.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, dc in next ch, *sc in next ch, dc in next ch; rep from * across.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, *sc in next dc, dc in next sc; rep from * across.

Rep Row 2 until piece measures about 9 in. (23 cm) from beginning. Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Thread tail through sts of last row and pull to gather. Knot securely.

FINISHING

Sew seam. Weave in ends.
